Recreation Vehicles Allowed More Time In State Parks

The Oregon Transportation Commission today approved a temporary rule as an amendment to State Park Rules and Regulations designed to assist in alleviating the severe problems being faced by owners of recreation vehicles as a result of the fuel shortage. The rule is effective immediately. A portion of the amendment will permit recreation vehicles to stay 30 consecutive days in any State Park overnight camping area that is open. Present time limit is seven consecutive days. Another portion of the amendment will permit storage at an individual campsite of a recreation vehicle for up to 30 days at a charge of \$1.00 per night. The regular fee will be charged when the unit is occupied. This amendment will apply to 10 per cent of the campsites in the parks that are now in operation during the winter. The amendment will expire on May 15. The rules will be in effect at the following seven parks now open: Fort Stevens, Cape Lookout, Beverly Beach, Jessie M. Honeyman, Bullards Beach, Harris Beach and Valley of the Rogue. On April 12, it will apply to all parks until the expiration date. The Oregon Coast Association and the Trailer Coach Association have worked closely with the Commission and the Parks and Recreation Branch staff in formulating the program.
