Adrian Education Assoc. Elects New Officers

Food Stamp Meeting For Food Retailers

Representatives of the U. S. Department of Agriculture will conduct two orientation and authorization meetings in Vale, May 8, for grocers who plan to participate in the food stamp program scheduled to be implemented in Malheur County July 1.

Both meetings will be held in the Commissioner's Room, County Courthouse, 251 "B" Street, West, Vale, on Wednesday, May 8, the first starting at 4 p.m. and the other beginning at 8 p.m.

Ken Lydrickson, officer-in-charge of USDA's Food and Nutrition Service field office in Boise, said food merchants must be authorized by USDA before they may accept food coupons. "There are some retailers," Lydrickson said, "who have previously been authorized to participate in the program. Those authorizations will be cancelled on June 30. Retailers holding such authorizations must reapply by May 31 in order to continue to participate in the program."

Promoting the interests of public education, advancing standards of the teaching profession, and securing conditions necessary to the greatest efficiency of teachers and schools are the intricate parts of the Adrian Education Association.

Lydrickson encouraged retailers to attend one of the meetings and to bring employees who will be in contact with food stamp customers so the program can be explained and questions answered. Authorization can be completed at a meeting. There is no charge.

Lydrickson said that retail grocer cooperation is vital to the success of the food stamp program and urged retailers who want more information to contact his office: Food and Nutrition Service, U. S.
