Bulldog Wrestlers Drop First Dual Meet

The Nyssa wrestlers lost their first dual of the season at Milton-Freewater Saturday to league rival Mac Hi 32-26.

Nyssa led throughout most of the match but then lost the last two weights by a pin and forfeit to drop the Bulldogs dual record to 7-1. Later in the day Nyssa raised its record to 8-1 with a 55-12 win over Wahtonka.

One of Nyssa's two undefeated wrestlers, Sam Hartley pinned Ron Doud of Mac Hi in the first round. The other undefeated is Chris Lords who did not wrestle. Lords is just recovering from an illness and has not resumed practice with his team.

Other winners by decision for Nyssa were Dan Simantel at 123, Kevin Adams at 157, and at 178 David Mitchell.

At 130, Nyssa's Scott Holcomb won by forfeit. Robert Gallegos at 148 was the only other Nyssa grappler to win by a pin. Gallegos pinned Alvin Jones in the third round.

In their next dual match Nyssa had no problem beating Wahtonka. Only three Nyssa wrestlers lost in the night cap.

The Bulldogs used four pins, four forfeits, and two decisions to beat the Eagles, 55-12.

Wahtonka got in the hole right off the start forfeiting to the first three Nyssa wrestlers.

Victor Suarez, Bill Tenson, and Sam Hartley all received forfeits.

Brad Holcomb, Kevin Adams, and Joe Joyce all had first round pins for the Bulldogs. David Mitchell had a second round pin.

Dan Simantel won a 12-0 decision and Rawleigh Perez beat his man 9-5 to finish up.

Nyssa Track Men In Portland

Two Nyssa track men, Curtis Moncur, and John Strickland, competed in the Oregon Invitational High School meet Saturday in Portland.

Moncur ran 6.55 in the 60-yard dash, missing second by one-one hundredth of a second.

John Strickland tossed the shot 44 feet to place sixth in the event. Strickland appeared to have difficulty with his timing in the different surroundings.

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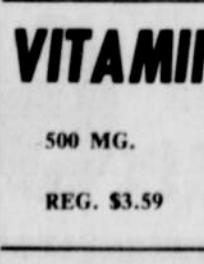
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
