Your County Agent Says

Of all of the crops grown here in Treasure Valley, the most abused and poorest yielding is pasture. Most people never compute the yield of this crop using pounds of milk or pounds of beef production per acre basis. As a result, most pasture owners can not tell you how much money their pasture is making—or losing—per acre.

The basis for a good pasture starts with the selection of an adapted high yielding grass variety. Orchard grass is a leading one for our better soils. The grass is usually combined with a legume such as Ladino clover or alfalfa to help supply nitrogen for better vegetative growth. Fawn or alta fescue are good grass variety selections for soils with some drainage problems or those on the alkaline side.

The poorest yielding grass and one that predominates in most of the old pastures—is blue grass. This crop makes a pleasant appearing ground cover, but produces a minimum amount of livestock forage. Many of these pastures should be taken out and replaced.
