Since the program was initiated on May 18, nearly 500 welfare recipients have found jobs and approximately 200 others will have their grants reduced due to employment. Savings of taxpayer dollars will add up to over \$110,000 a month.

Public Welfare staff have been working closely with potential employers in communities throughout Oregon and the State Employment Division to secure jobs for welfare clients. In December, 1974, six months prior to implementation of the job placement program, 1,902 welfare cases were closed; in

June of this year 2,946 cases were closed.

"The high number of job placements was due to the cooperation of our staff, welfare clients, other divisions of the State Human Resources Department, and employers across the state," said Peet. "We are extremely pleased with the success of the program to date and are optimistic about its potential in the next few months," he added.

"We believe this is a firm indication that welfare recipients are genuinely interested in returning to part or full-time employment if they have the opportunity," he continued.

Welfare recipients interested in obtaining assistance with job hunting or potential employers with job openings are encouraged to contact their local welfare offices.

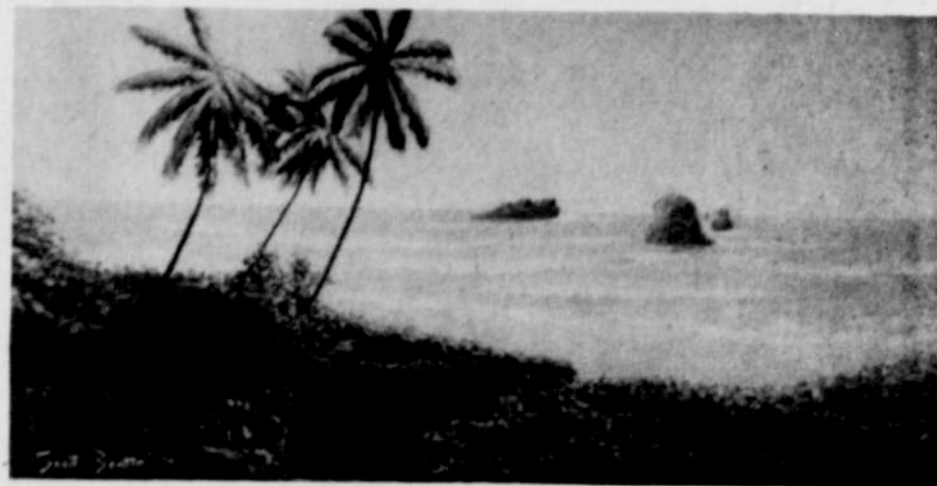
