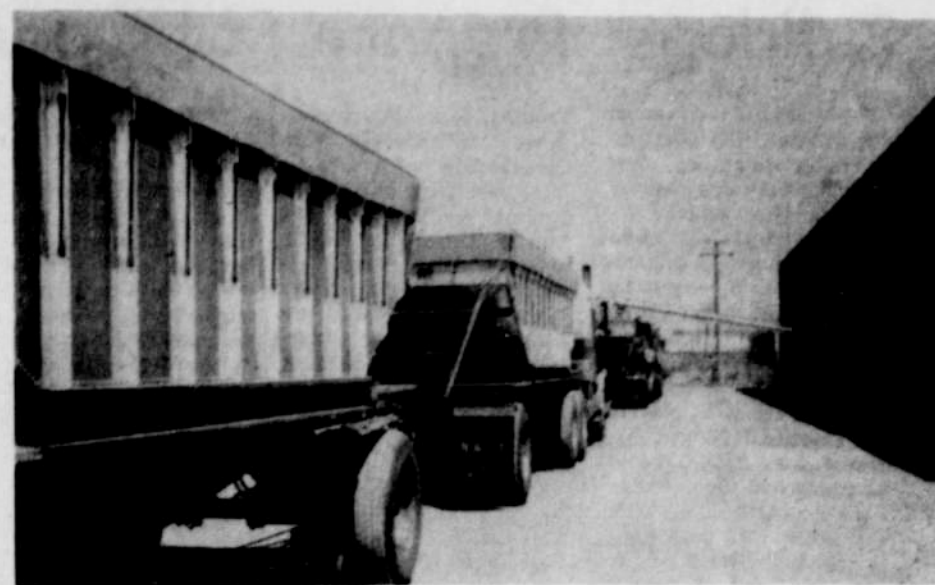

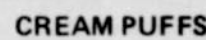

CREAM PUFFS

There are two secrets to making cream puff paste. First, you must add all the flour at once. Don't be afraid, it won't lump! Second, to keep the shells crisp the steam must be released as soon as they are removed from the oven by puncturing with a knife. For large puffs, cut off the top and remove the soft dough inside to prevent the puffs from getting soggy.



- 1 cup water
1/2 cup Blue Bonnet Margarine
1 cup unsifted flour
1/4 teaspoon salt
4 eggs

Bake at 400°F. 45 to 50 minutes, or until done. Remove from baking sheet and cool on wire racks. (6) When puffs are cool, cut off tops, scoop out soft dough; fill and replace tops. To serve as a main dish, fill with creamed eggs, meat or fish. To serve as a dessert, fill with custard, pudding, ice cream or whipped cream. If desired, top with chocolate, butterscotch or favorite dessert sauce. Makes 10 puffs.
