TVCC Offers Classes in Weaving

Treasure Valley Community College will be offering a new course during the summer session called Creative Art Project (weaving). The two credit course will be taught by Janet Takami, a recent Oregon State University graduate, whose major area of study was textiles.

The course will cover such activities as simple loom construction and beginning as well as advanced techniques in weaving. Special sessions will be devoted to spinning and dyeing wool from natural plants. In addition, there will be demonstrations and practical application of

pattern weaving and loom formed clothing.

The classes will be held in the college's Art Shed on Monday, Wednesdays and Thursdays, 9 a.m. to 12 noon with the first class slated for Wednesday June 23.

Tax Levy Measure

PROPOSAL

BE IT RESOLVED, that since the Treasure Valley Community College District has no tax base, thus requiring voter approval for a tax levy necessary to finance, in part, the operating budget for the district. The district's budget committee has approved an operating budget which is \$112,391.00 greater than the operating budget for the preceding year.

That portion of the proposed budget to be financed by the levy of local taxes for the year 1976-1977 is \$859,400.00 which if approved will be \$69,546.00 greater than that portion of the operating budget financed by local taxes for the previous year.

The Board has calculated that the tax rate per \$1,000.00 of true cash value, if approved, shall be \$2.61.
