CONFUSED ABOUT WHEN YOU ARE DUE to get a new Oregon photo driver's license?

Then check this photo license renewal calendar and look at your driver's license for the exact expiration date—the day of the month and the year.

If your license is due to expire during the last half of 1976 or the first half of 1977 and the date on which it expires, such as August 5, 1976, is shown on the calendar, you are due to get a photo license when you renew. This means you must renew in person at a Motor Vehicles Division office or examination station. Your new license will be valid for four years and you will pay the new \$9 fee.

If your exact expiration date is not shown on the calendar, you should renew by mail.

The Motor Vehicles Division says there is one catch: if your driver's license is due to expire early in July, such as the first, third or fifth of that month, and you renew before July 1, you will be issued an old-style paper license. No photo licenses will be issued until July 1.

The Division says it will take four years to convert all 1.5 million Oregon drivers to the new style license. Drivers with even-numbered birthdays (the missing dates on the calendar) are not scheduled to get the four year photo license until sometime after July, 1978.

Taxing Districts Must Certify Levy

Taxing districts must submit their tax levy to the Assessor's office not later than July 15, according to Malheur County Assessor

Oscar Bratton. Bratton said that Oregon's local budget law ORS 310.060 requires that taxing districts shall give to the County

Assessor the proper documents no later than July 15 each year. Proper budget forms, Bratton said, are prescribed by

the Department of Revenue for this use. The LB 50 form shall state the total amount of money to be raised by taxation; the amount levied inside the constitutional limitation; the amount for bonded indebtedness and interest; and the amount to be levied outside the constitutional limitation and date approved.

Bratton said that the law provides that for a good and sufficient reason the taxing district can request the Assessor give an extension of the July 15 cut off date. This request should be received by July 15 to be considered.

The problem, Bratton emphasized, becomes acute if the extension is made for a very long period. Oregon law requires that the Assessor deliver the Assessment Roll to the Sheriff by October 15. In order to meet this requirement it is necessary that tax rates be figured by the end of August and the Summary of Assessment and Tax Roll sheet be ready for the printers by the middle of September. If the levy is not approved by the extended date the taxing district should submit the amount levied within their constitutional limitation which does not require voters approval; the bonded indebtedness principal, interest and other charges thereon and/or special levies previously approved by the voters.

Bratton said that if the voter approval is given after October 15 the levy goes directly to the Sheriff's Tax Office where with the assistance of the Assessor's office an additional tax rate is established for the new levy. This will result in the taxpayer of this taxing district receiving two tax statements, one for November 15 payment and another for a later date.

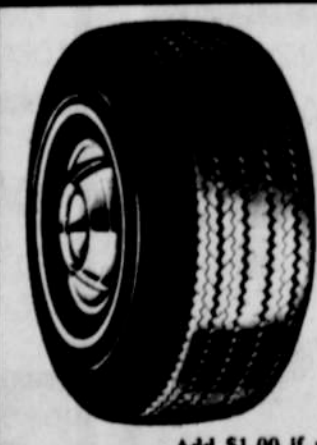
