## Your Property Taxes

By Oscar B. Brenton, Malheur County Assessor

This is the first of a series of articles explaining the responsibilities and duties of the County Assessor, the framework of the State laws that he must work within and the necessary knowledge and experience he must have to qualify for the position of Assessor and carry out these duties.

Some of the many laws that require the involvement of the Department of Revenue in local property assessments will be mentioned and explained. The Assessor to be a proper administrator must be knowledgeable of the laws pertaining to the local property assessment. There are in excess of 800 laws (Oregon Revised Statutes) that govern the manner local property tax assessments are made and processed. After each legislative session the Depart-

ment of Revenue publishes a new book, Property Assessment and Taxation Laws and Administrative Rules, this book is enlarging at the rate of 40 to 50 pages each publication.

It is a constant duty of the Assessor to be aware of the present status of the assessment laws. Some of the more frequently used laws will be explained and new 1975 laws reviewed that could possibly save you future tax dollars.
