Q. I tend to be overweight, so I'm already worried about my baby daughter. Is there anything I can do now to establish good patterns for her later in life?



OVERFED INFANTS— They're more likely to become overweight adults.

A. It's now believed that excessive caloric intake in infancy may contribute to chronic obesity. And the problem may be even greater when the genetic risk is high.

The way in which new foods are introduced and the timing of this procedure are important considerations. More and more doctors believe that breast feeding or an infant formula such as Enfamil, as the sole source of feeding during the first six months of life, reduces the risk of excessive nutrient intake. And using formula or breast feeding for the remainder of the first year as the infant beverage—supplemented judiciously with solid foods—will help assure that the infant's nutritional needs will continue to be adequately met.

Savings Bond Sales Over \$7 Billion

The U. S. Treasury today revealed that U. S. Savings Bonds sales in fiscal year ending June 1976 exceeded \$7 billion for the first time in history. Actual sales were \$7,293 million. \$3,903 million were sold in the January to June period which is 8% higher than sales in the first half of 1975.

The State Savings Bonds office feels the Bicentennial promotion and spirit is a major contributing factor to the constant surge in sales. Sales were up 4% in the first quarter showing a 10% increase in the second quarter.

Nearly sixty percent of all bonds sold are purchased on the Payroll Savings Plan. This great savings program makes a major contribution to the sound management of the Public Debt as the average life of a Savings Bond is six years; better than double the life of the marketable debt.

Sales have exceeded redemptions for 33 consecutive months. The net cash in flow (cash sales in excess of redemptions plus accrued interest) for the six-month period in June totals to a half billion dollars. There was a \$4.2 billion net change in amount outstanding during the fiscal year.

Deep Water, Ancient Ships. Willard Bascom - The book contains photographs of artifacts and sculptures recovered in the past, descriptions of the equipment and ships to be used in deep-water searching, sketches of various kinds of recovery devices, and an appendix of the legal technicalities of salvage operations.

The Revolutionary War. Bart McDowell - This book will take you, as it took the McDowell family, across the land of the colonists to relive their victories and defeats. In all, 572 strips are presented, as selected by Garry Trudeau and encompassing the full Doonesbury canon, from its cozy campus origins at the frazzled end of the sixties through the stumbling first half of the seventies.

The Eden Express. Mark Vonnegut - In 1969 Mark Vonnegut graduated from Swarthmore college. Bored with East Coast academia, suspicious of his father's sudden literary notoriety, and determined to stay true to the principles of hippiedom, Mark headed for the wilds of British Columbia to build a commune and find his panacea. Two years later, on Valentine's Day, 1971, Vonnegut was committed to Hollywood Psychiatric Hospital in Vancouver - diagnosed severely schizophrenic.
