**MIXED DOUBLES ANYONE?**

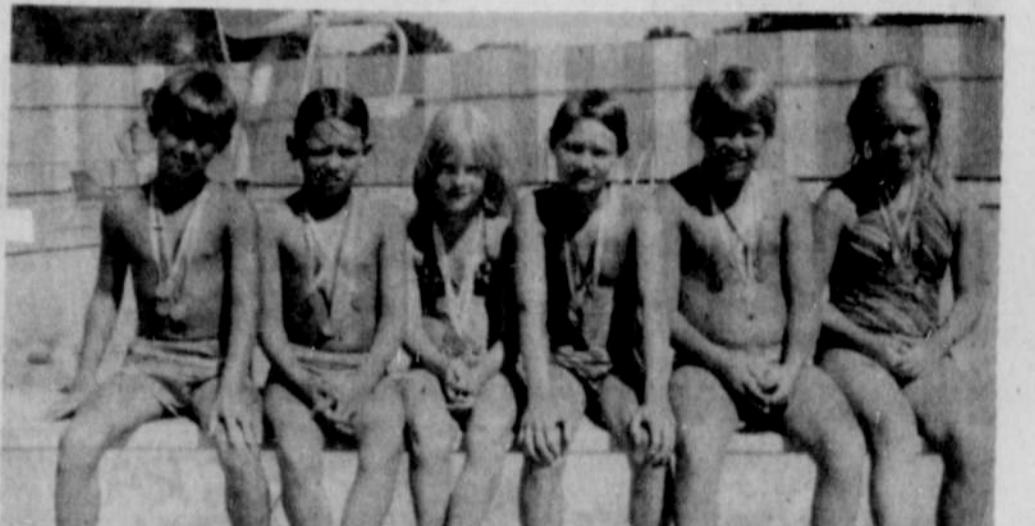

Finding only one court vacant, the foursome played anyway—thus originating mixed doubles. Today, it is the fastest growing segment of tennis. For example, thousands of players from all over the country are participating in a family mixed doubles tournament—the Equitable Family Tennis Challenge, sponsored by The Equitable Life Assurance Society of the U.S. In the Equitable Family Tennis Challenge entrants are teamed in either mother-son, father-daughter, grandmother-grandson and grandfather-granddaughter combinations. After regional and sectional matches, the finalists compete at the West Side Tennis Club in Forest Hills, N.Y., at the same time the U.S. Open Championships will be played there. With mixed doubles played all in the family, no matter what the score, it's a love-all game.
