Holli Pittz will be competing in Girls 11-12 200 yd free relay.

Leslie Jessop made "A" State time in 50 back, 50 breast and 50 free. She will be competing in all three individual events and 11-12 Girls 200 yard free relay.

Julie Matthews, made "A" State times in 50 yd and 100 yd back, 50 yd free, 50 and 100 yd breast. She will be competing in 50 yd. breast stroke, 50 yd. freestyle and Girls 11-12 200 yd. free relay.

Denise Blanch made "A" State time in 50 yd free and will be competing in 50 yd free style and Girls 11-12 200 yd. free relay. No qualifying times are required for relay teams to go to "A" State. But in individual events, each swimmer must make a certain time to be able to go to "A" State.

Scott Anderson made "A" State times in 50 yd and 100 yd back, 50 breast, 50 and 100 yd free style. 100 yd individual medley. He will be competing in 50 yd back, 100 yd back and 50 yd free style at "A" State.

Todd Sarazin made "A" State time in 50 back and will be competing in that event at "A" State.

Bob Bass made "A" State times in 50 yd and 100 yd free style and 100 yd breast stroke, he will be competing in 50 yd free style and 100 yd breast stroke.

Dates Set for Tag Sales Cutoff

A new regulation for Oregon game hunters is in effect this year that will cut off the sale of big game tags at midnight the day before the season starts.

The sale of elk bowhunting tags will end at midnight August 26.

The sale of mule deer and blacktail deer tags will end at midnight September 30.

The sale of Rocky Mountain elk tags will end at midnight October 28.

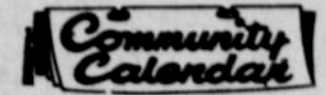
The sale of Roosevelt elk tags will end at midnight November 11.

If you do not have your tag by the above dates, you will not be able to buy one for this year's season. This system has been suggested by some sportsmen as a way to prevent violators from going hunting for big game, shooting an animal, and then running back to town to buy a tag. As a result of these requests, the Commission enacted the rule this year to give the system a try.

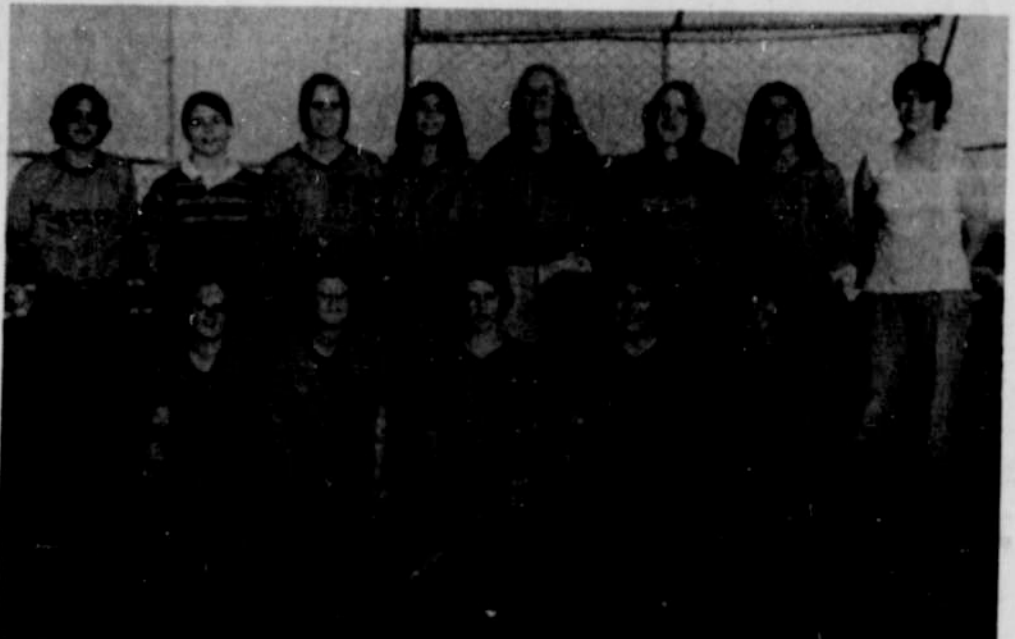

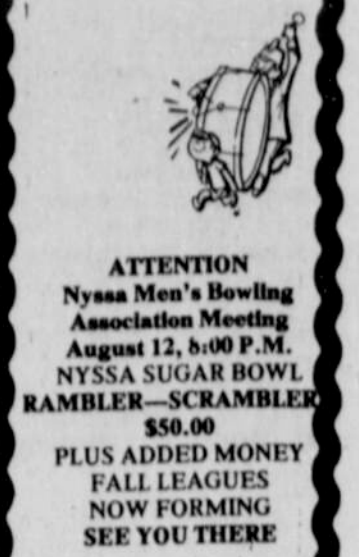

Horseshoe

The clang of metal shoes will soon fill the air when the Fourth Annual Open Horseshoe Tournament begins on August 16.

Things began back in 1974 when lively competition was dominated by Gene Chester, Neil Mathews and Bob Wilson over a field of sixteen entrants. After leading the league for five weeks, Bill Wilson was dropped into second place by Gene Chester, perennial strong man.

In the finals, however, Wilson defeated Chester by dropping double ringers to win the first game 26-19 then went on to route Chester 25-8, to become the first Champion.

In 1975 however Chester was not to be denied, winning his league handily. He went on to earn the City title by trouncing Neil Mathews 25-19, then performing an unheard task by annihilating Mathews 25-0 in the final game.

During the 1976 season former Champion Gene Chester was forced out of competition due to health. Neil Mathews surged to the fore after a slow league start. He hammered his way to final victory over constant Jim Phelps to earn the 1976 City Title.

City Manager Henry Schneider, who is reviewing entries said: "This year's dark horses could well be Jim Phelps or Henry Anderson, with Gene Docktor in strong contention. Ralph Werner came out of nowhere and gave former Champion Wilson a bad scare with his fast finish."
