Insulation Manufacturing Business Location In Parma

The Jon Ball family have started a new business in Parma that manufactures low-cost, high-quality cellulose insulation by chemically treating recyclable waste products.

Cellulose insulation is manufactured from old newspaper and has one of the highest values of all types of insulation. Cellulostic fiber has about 30% more insulation value than rock wool for the same installed thickness. Six inches of cellulostic fiber gives a R-value of 22 and ten inches gives a R-value of 38. It can be used in both attics and walls.

Their product has been

tested by the U.S. Testing Company, Inc., in Los Angeles and found to be lightweight, non-toxic, non-corrosive, safe to handle, vermin resistant and a flame retardant. It passes flame retardant tests comparable to: UL#723, NFPA#255, UBC# 42-1, ANSI #A2-5 and ASTM #E-84. It has been given a Class I rating by Uniform Building Code, a Class A rating by National Fire Protection Association, and approved for use by FHA.

Bonds Boom
