

HOW TO PAY STATE'S EXPENSES

Statement Issued by the State Board of Levy, Showing the Amounts Appropriated by the Legislature for the Years 1901 and 1902, Together With the Amounts Provided for Last Year, and the Sums Required for the Year 1902, for State's Expenses.

Yesterday the State Board of Levy made its annual tax levy, as shown in another column of this issue of the Statesman, and with the notice of the levy is issued the following

STATEMENT.

Consisting of all items of expense, given separately, to which the state will be subject, under existing laws, for the fiscal year ending December 31, 1902; also interest on unpaid warrants, and also the sum provided by law for the current expenses of the Oregon National Guard, and the sum of forty-seven thousand five hundred (\$47,500) dollars for the support of the University of Oregon.

Amount appropriated by the Legislature for the fiscal year ending December 31, 1901, for the current expenses of the state (including January 1, 1901, and payment of certain special claims).
