Roads Getting Ready.

New York, Oct. 21.—Anthracite coal-carrying roads, through orders just issued by the general managers, have called back into service all trainmen, station agents and clerks laid off in consequence of the suspension of coal transportation during the strike. The Philadelphia & Reading and the Jersey Central Roads will retain about 2,500 and 5,000 trainmen this week, and other coal-carrying roads probably 6,000 more.

The coal roads are making preparations to rush anthracite to the market as soon as the miners go back to work. The Reading alone already has nearly 6,000 cars idle tracked near the mines.
