SALEM AS A COLLEGE AND SCHOOL CITY.

If an observer did not know from outside sources that Salem is becoming an educational center, the greater number of school children and college students to be seen on our streets between school hours would certainly impress that fact upon his mind. Not for fifteen years has this been so noticeable as since the school year began last month.

This can be attributed to several causes—the better condition and equipment of Willamette University, which, for several years had a difficult fight to keep its head above water, figuratively speaking; to the increased efficiency of our public schools and to the establishment of high school grades which are being liberally patronized by many who, but for this opportunity, would be seeking elsewhere the advantages they furnish at home.

Forty years ago Salem had a population of 1,200 souls, but the Willamette University was the leading institution of its kind in the state and was liberally patronized. Having a primary department at that time, the only public school in the city was held in the Central Building, still standing, and being used for the same purpose. For the population of Salem, the prestige the University gave it was immense and it had all the air of a college town to a greater extent than has been the case at any time for thirty years.

But under its renewed life and improved condition the situation is changing and its increasing ascendancy is felt and appreciated in many ways. Every assurance points to its continued growth and widening influence, the proof of which, aside from other evidences which are tangible, is found in the interest its students are taking in the social and educational affairs of the city. It is a reminder of the "olden times."

And our public schools were never before so well attended or in better condition. With an active and conscientious superintendent, assisted by a corps of efficient and painstaking, though grossly underpaid, teachers, there are no better public schools in the state than are to be found in Salem and with the high school adjunct recently established, which is doing exceptionally good work in a much needed field, Salem is as well equipped as any city of its population in the United States for taking the six-year-old into its charge and fully preparing it for almost any kind of professional or business career that can be named.

Upon this basis, in connection with its healthful surroundings and excellent social conditions, Salem is fast becoming and will soon be acknowledged as the educational center of the state.

BEET SUGAR AS AN OREGON PRODUCT.

For thirty years there was scarcely a product raised in Oregon for export but wheat. This was partly because the country is so well adapted by nature for its production, and also for the reason that in all new countries it requires time and an increased population to develop natural resources that are not apparent at the beginning. But the days of exclusive wheat raising in Oregon are past—have been noticeably passing for ten years. A new agricultural era can be said to have arrived when, instead of from 50 to 100 teams standing in the streets of Salem loaded with wheat to be unloaded at the Salem mills, every day for six weeks at a time during the fall of the year, we are actually importing enormous quantities of different kinds of grain foods every week for home consumption.

Willamette valley mills are shipping wheat from Eastern Oregon to be ground into flour for the local trade—and times were never before so good, judging from the excellent condition of business in all lines, prices of farm products and the demand for labor at good wages, as now.

This is a plain indication that we have emerged from the era of a single product, which, if for any reason, is not in good demand, leaves everybody in straitened circumstances. All new countries pass through precisely the same experience that has been ours, and are always the better for its departure. For thirty years we took all our eggs to market in one basket, and when any mishap overtook us on the road the result could not be otherwise than disastrous.

These thoughts have been suggested by the statement recently given out that the La Grande beet sugar factory, which is just now in the midst of consuming this year's crop, will have a greater output than ever before, and that the enterprise has long since passed beyond the experimental stage. This is the eighth season for this plant and it has proven one of the most effective agencies in making Union county a specially prosperous section of the state. The raising of beets for this factory gives employment to thousands of men, women and children during a good portion of the year, scattering money in small quantities among many families much as the hop industry does in the Willamette valley.

A few years ago the enterprising people of Newberg made every preparation for the starting of a beet sugar factory in their town, but the firm which was
