THE NORTHERN TYROL.

A LIGHT HEARTED, MERRY, SIMPLE AND PICTURESQUE RACE.

Old World Customs and Old Time Superstitions—Religion of the Tyrol—The National Costume—Not a Race of Hard Workers—Beggars—Gypsies.

The Austrian Tyrol, though visited by many, is by no means so well known as Switzerland and many other parts of the European continent.

The Tyrolers possess a light hearted, merry race, very simple, very superstitious, clinging innovations of all kinds and clinging with wonderful tenacity to their old world customs.

Another story is that a poor girl—a servant on a farm—was so fond of dancing that she believed she could dance forever.

The religion of the Tyrol, indeed of Austria generally, is Roman Catholicism.

The costume of the Tyrolers is a pretty one, consisting of a stiff dress, with a very full skirt.

The national costume of the Tyrolers is more picturesque, consisting of knitted dark blue or white stockings, knee breeches, waistcoat with two rows of silver buttons.

The Tyrolers are by no means fond of very hard work.

On Saturdays they are generally processions, which start from the church, consisting of a large procession of the villagers.
