MONEY FOR ROADS.

The bill to give fifteen thousand dollars for a road to let the people of the Northwest coast and of certain valleys have access to the inner world was much and ably discussed this forenoon. Two objections are urged to such bills one the constitutional inhibition against "special or local laws for laying, opening and working on highways."
