The Polk county court house question will reach a solution on Wednesday next. The commissioners will then canvass the petitions and remonstrances.

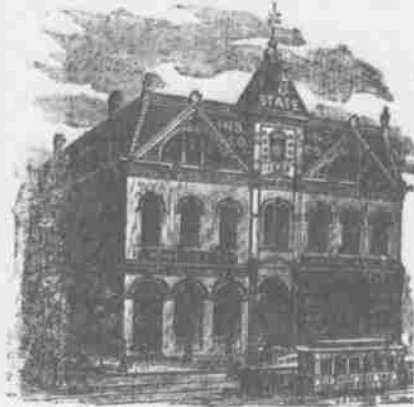
