Monkey jugs were much used in Southern cities during the war, when ice for cooling the drinking water was not to be had.

Those most commonly seen would hold two or three gallons. In shape they were much like ordinary earthenware jugs, but instead of having a single opening at the top for pouring liquid in or out, that position was occupied by a handle for lifting or carrying the jug.

At one end of this handle was an opening of the usual size for pouring in water and at the other a nipple with an opening half as big as a lead pencil for pouring the water out.

The jugs are made of a very fine, porous red clay, which permits the water from the inside to percolate through, thus keeping the outside of the jug moist all the time.

It is the constant evaporation of this moisture that cools the water in the jug, which performs its functions all the better if it is set where a breeze can play upon it.

They are much used for cooling water in Arizona and in the mining camps, and are a real luxury wherever ice or a well of cold water or a cold spring are not at hand.
