A Second Sugar Trust. NEW YORK, March 7.—The combination in the sugar trust is greater and more widespread in its ramifications than the sugar trust itself. It has practically consummated the object sought, and this will equalize the selling price of retailers.

The senate committee ordered a favorable report upon the bill to appropriate money to reimburse the state of Oregon for expenses incurred to aid in suppressing the rebellion. The amount is \$376,272; wherever the state paid interest on loans to meet these expenses, that amount, after being determined, shall also be paid.
