The Political Situation in Germany.

No one can longer doubt that Germany has undergone a peaceful revolution from an iron-handed rule of imperial despotism to the milder government of a prince who seeks to rule by love of the masses.

In Bavaria, in Baden, in Saxony and in Hesse the name of Prussia is abhorred, and in Wurtemberg the situation has become so ominous and grows of popular dissatisfaction.

The opening of the Reichstag and the royal speeches are awaited with the keenest interest. Dr. Windthorst claims three indispensable conditions in return for his support of the government.

For the moment colonial affairs overshadow home politics. Vonderheydt, the financial backer of the East Africa Company, recently declared that Bismarck's departure was the sign of a new and energetic colonial policy.

The exact scope of the expedition is not yet known. It is certain, however, that the emperor will decline to consent to the adoption of any colonial policy antagonistic to that of England.

The emperor's solicitude regarding the army has been further shown in an imperial order to the effect that, in view of its incompleteness, the reserve infantry military officers system hitherto pursued, which provided that officers must come from the ranks of the nobility, must be extended to include those noble by character, in order that the sons of honorable middle-class families may hold appointments in the army.

A Berlin telegram to the New York Tribune says: The Southern states of the German empire are beginning to manifest very serious signs of revolt against the despotic and encroaching nature of the control of the Prussian government.
