CRIMES AND CASUALTIES.

A Man at Engine the Victim of a Mill Accident.

FULL PARTICULARS OF THE EXPLOSION.

List of the Killed and Description by an Eye-witness.

DEATH FROM THE BELT.
ETOWNE, Or., July 16.—The unfortunate working man, Frank Jauch, an employe in the Springfield mills, who was struck by a large belt, which slipped from its pulley, died this morning, after lying unconscious for several days.

POWDER EXPLOSION.
CINCINNATI, July 16.—A terrible explosion occurred yesterday at King's powder mills on the Little Miami railroad, twenty-nine miles from this city. Ten persons were killed and nearly a score seriously injured. Two empty freight cars were being rolled onto a side track where a car containing 500 kegs of powder was standing. As the cars struck there was an explosion and immediately after another car containing 800 kegs of gunpowder exploded, making 1300 kegs altogether. William Frailey, a brakeman, was standing on one of the empty cars when the explosion occurred. No trace of his body has been found. Five other persons supposed to be employes of the powder company were killed.

Persons describe the scene in the vicinity of the explosion as awful. Fences, trees and buildings are strewn hundreds of feet in all directions from the explosion.

Peter's cartridge factory was literally demolished by the explosion, and the fire from its combustible contents completed the work of destruction.

About thirty girls are thought to have been at work in the factory at the time of the explosion and most of them are thought to be badly hurt. Passengers who arrived on the train say ten persons were killed, and that it is possible more bodies are in the debris.

LIST OF THE KILLED.
CINCINNATI, O., July 16.—The following is a list of the killed at the explosion yesterday at King's mill:—Mrs. Jas. Deacon, Henry Reynolds, Sam'l Stephens, Mrs. Jas. Meze and child, Wm. Francey, Fred Miller and child, a brakeman, R. Williams, Baby Elstine, Nick Snyder, unknown man. There are a dozen injured, some of them will die.

AN EYE WITNESS
thus describes the occurrence: I saw two cars bump against what I supposed to be empty cars on a side track and in an instant later I heard a rumbling noise; then the very ground beneath me seemed to open and I saw puff of smoke, followed a second later by another. Then the cars disappeared, and the station and powder house and dwelling seemed to follow. The fire at the carriage house seemed to be instantaneous. The building did not catch on fire in the ordinary way, but the flames seemed to penetrate all the doors and windows from all sides. I saw a number of women get out, but some certainly must have perished. The dwelling house below the carriage house was blown from its foundation and dashed to the ground. In this building a mother and child are lost. All the railroad tracks are twisted and torn like so much paper. Telegraph poles and wires burned like so much tinder.

LATEST FROM THE MINNESOTA CYCLOS.
MINNEAPOLIS, Minn., July 16.—This morning the searchers found three missing bodies of victims of the Lake Gervais cyclone. They were close together in a marshy portion of the lake, two hundred feet from the shore. The bodies of Chas. Schurmeier and Rev. M. P. Paehle were considerably mutilated, but that of Mrs. J. H. Schurmeier was not disfigured.

LAKE CITY, Minn., July 16.—In the Lake Pepin disaster nineteen additional bodies have been taken out of the water this morning.

STILL MORE DEAD.
LAKE CITY, July 16.—In all twenty-five more bodies have been recovered to-day, making a total of 90. It is believed that ten to fifteen are still missing.

NOT DRUNK.
LAKE CITY, Minn., July 16.—Judge Bayrell of Argyle, who was on the boat that sunk in Lake Pepin Sunday, gives positive evidence against the charge of drunkenness. He says the captain was not only sober, but was fully conscious of the presence of the storm, although not fully apprehending its gravity. The captain walked through the cabin quietly trying to calm the excited passengers, telling them he did not think there was any danger, but if any wished to do so they could put on life preservers and prepare for the worst possibility.

IN PROBATE.—The county court is in session this afternoon, considering the matter of the estate of David Grubb, deceased.

The Salem Mandolin club gave a concert on the electric cars last evening, between 8 and 9 o'clock. This is the beginning of a series of such concerts, managed by H. C. Epply.

AMERICA WINS.
PHILADELPHIA, Penn., July 16.—In the great international Cricket match to-day between Canada and the United States the latter won by one inning and thirty-one runs.

APPOINTMENTS.
WASHINGTON, D. C., July 16.—Prof. James R. Seley has been appointed to the position of assistant secretary of the navy. The President has to-day sent the following names to the senate: A. D. Nettleton, Minnesota, to be assistant secretary of the treasury. Receiver of public moneys, Jacob R. Weltie at Olympia, Washington.

FROM CHILL.
LONDON, Eng., July 16.—Latest advices from Chill state that the strikers in the nitrate district numbered seven thousand men and that a conflict occurred between the strikers and troops. Forty strikers were killed and wounded.

A HERO BURIED.
NEW YORK, N. Y., July 16.—The remains of General Fremont were laid at rest this morning at Trinity cemetery, amid great civic and military honors.

PENSION FOR MRS. FREMONT.
WASHINGTON, D. C., July 16.—Senator Teller introduced a bill in the senate to-day granting a pension of six thousand dollars a year to the widow of the late General John C. Fremont.

OHIO REPUBLICANS.
CLEVELAND, O., July 16.—The Ohio republican state convention met this morning. Ex-Governor Foraker's appearance on the stage was a signal for prolonged and enthusiastic cheering. On conclusion of a short speech by Brinsford, chairman of the state central committee, the ex-governor was introduced and delivered an address.

THE TICKET.
When Convention reassembled after a recess Ex-Governor Foraker was chosen permanent chairman, declined the honor and Congressman Thompson was chosen. Daniel J. Ryan was nominated for secretary of state by acclamation, and Thaddeus A. Minshall supreme judge. **HOME AND FAMILY DESTROYED.**
VALPARAISO, Ind., July 16.—The residence of John Hammen burned this morning. His wife and four children burned to death.

MURDER BY APACHES.
GLOBE, Ariz., July 16.—Information was received last night that resulted in the discovery of the dead body of Edward Baker, at his cabin in the Sierra Ancha mountains, 40 miles north of Globe. He is supposed to have been murdered on the 14th instant. The fact that his body had been mutilated about the head points to his killing by Apaches. A number of horses were stolen and his cabin looted.
