MISCELLANY.
RAILROAD SPRUCE.
New York, Aug. 9.—The first train which left Grand Central depot this morning passed out at 4 p. m. with four cars attached occupied by mail sorters. There were no passengers aboard. The trip on the road is complete. Every trainman, switchman, engineer and conductor except those necessary to attend to the mail trains have stopped work. Five freight trains left over West Shore road last night. The strikers all conducted themselves in an orderly manner. They say they are determined not to go to work until the discharged men are all reinstated. Executive board of district assembly 246, was in session all night. Inspector Byrnes remained at his post all night and reserves are held at most of the precincts. To-day he has detectives all along the bridges and in the tunnels. No freight cars are run today, but Inspector Byrnes has received dispatches to the effect that the officials will try to run passenger trains.

There is considerable improvement in the situation at the Grand Central depot this morning. No longer is the temporary suspension of passenger traffic has been taken down. Between six and ten o'clock seven trains came in, some through trains, others local, made up of cars stalled at Harlem and Manhattan. Vice President Webb said he did not think matters would assume such gigantic proportions but that men can be found to man the trains. A majority of those who have left are switchmen and yardmen and their places are being filled as rapidly as possible.

THE STRIKE ABOUT OVER.
Vice-president Webb estimates the number out at between four and five hundred. At the yards of the West Shore road it is reported that all trains are arriving and departing on time. At 11:50 Webb said everything was running smoothly. There is more applicants for work than places to fill.

ASSUMING A SERIOUS PHASE.
The engineers and Knights of Labor have arranged for a conference. Everything looks as if the engineers would go out to-night and this will virtually stop all traffic.

THE CONDITION AT ALBANY.
ALBANY, N. Y., Aug. 9.—The situation of the strike here is more firm than last night. The only men at work are engineers and a few fire men. Western trains which came before noon are still here. On the first western train was attached a passenger coach having aboard General Alger and party on their way to the G. A. R. encampment at Boston. Only one train started south and that was made up of mail cars and two passenger coaches. The strikers, when the train was about to be switched over the bridge across the river, refused to let the switch be set properly and the police had to be called on to disperse them.

EVERYTHING GOES.
New York, Aug. 9, 4:50 p. m.—At 4 o'clock this afternoon the New York Central is almost completely tied up in this city to Buffalo, only trains to run being those carrying mail. The strikers include all men except engineers and firemen. It is now announced that all freight engineers are expected to go out to-night.

ANOTHER BIG ESTATE IN TROUBLE.

A HUNGLING LAW AT BEST.
New York, N. Y., Aug. 9.—Leading lawyers assert that the Kemmerer execution by electricity will tend to bring about the discharge of five-murdering by electric death. If the legislators in special session should see fit to repeal the present law calling for execution by electricity, the hanging sentences passed on these men will be null and void, and if tried again, the lawyers assert it would be claimed their lives could not again be put in jeopardy.

WASHINGTON.
MYSTERIOUS MATTER OF STATE.
WASHINGTON, D. C., Aug. 9.—The department of state has received a dispatch dated La Libertad from Minister Mizner to Guatemala. The department declined to make public the telegram or the instructions in reply.

A RIOT FEARED IN INDIAN TERRITORY.
WASHINGTON, D. C., Aug. 9.—The secretary of the Interior received a telegram from Mr. Bennett, Indian agent at Muskogee, Indian Territory, saying Chickasaw situation is serious. There is great danger of an outbreak on the 14th instant, the day of election, on account of the disfranchisement of "Squawmen." Troops will be at Fort Gibson in readiness to respond to any order necessary to suppress a riot.

PARAGRAPHS.
The United States coast survey steamer McArthur has left San Francisco for Santa Barbara channel to act as a stake boat during the official trial of the new cruiser San Francisco, which is expected to occur there next week.

The Sorocco mine, near Hermosillo, in Sonora, has been flooded and twenty miners drowned.

Indiana reports to the state agricultural board that the wheat yield is about 65 per cent. average crop, and corn will mature half a crop. Fruit is a failure.

According to the report of the state board of agriculture, of Ohio, the present indications show a decline of 6 per cent. in the wheat prospect since the estimate of July 1.

Henry George in an interview yesterday with London people, talked enthusiastically of his Australian reception, which he regarded as more flattering to himself and favorable to his theories than any he had ever received. Mr. George declared his belief that the imperial federation was waiting.
