

UNIVERSITY NOTES.

GERVAIS ITEMS.

Increase of Taxes.

Baker City Revieller: Under our system of valuation for taxes the proportion of deductions for indebtedness steadily increases. That is, the deductions year by year increase at a more rapid rate than the taxable property. And this will surely continue as owners of property acquire more and more skill in the art of making indebtedness for the purpose of wiping out valuations. Most of the increase of indebtedness comes from the wealthy class, who have credit, can go to debt and are learning all the time new and deft methods of making one dollar claimed as debt offset three to five dollars' worth of property on the assessment rolls. In this way a large part of the property of the wealthy classes escapes taxation; and it will continue to escape more and more, till deduction of indebtedness is disallowed. If the system was devised to help the man of small property, its effect is to give the man of large property an easy means of escaping payment of taxes.

No rich man need pay a dollar under our present system, unless he wants to pay. He can go to debt, and by claiming deductions wipe out everything. It is notorious that great numbers do this. Through deductions of indebtedness two-thirds or more of the property of the wealthy classes in Oregon escapes.

OREGON.

Oregon's Founders Were French Canadians.

The valley of the Columbia river, made known by the exploration of Lewis and Clark, attracted the attention of the great fur companies. John Jacob Astor planted a trading house in Oregon, but the threatening clouds of impending war with England induced him to transfer his establishments to the British Northwest and Hudson Bay Companies. None cared to plant settlements. The whole desire was to induce the Indians to slaughter the great food supply which nature had supplied the native tribes, in order to sell the skins to the trading companies.

The associations employed many French-Canadians, light-hearted, cheerful, enduring men, who have left their impress on all our western country. When Dr. McLoughlin became superintendent he took a great interest in these people and about 1826 induced several whose services were only occasionally required to settle down on the lovely valley of the Willamette, where in the midst of forests the hand of nature seemed to have cleared a rich and fertile prairie for human habitation. Many acted on his advice, and lands were laid off and cultivated; their industry was well repaid, and in peace and comfort the first white settlement in Oregon began.

Among these settlers the names of Joseph Gervais, Stephen Lucier and Peter Belque appear prominent. The settlement was firmly established and prosperous when the Methodist mission from the United States arrived in 1834, and began their labors, out of which American settlements grew some years later, at least ten years after the French-Canadian settlement in the Willamette. Here the first chapel for Christian service was reared, in anticipation of the arrival of a priest for whom they had applied to the Right Rev. Dr. Provencher, bishop of Jolupolis, on the Red River. It was not, indeed, till 1839 that Rev. F. N. Blanchet, from Canada, the future archbishop of Oregon City, began to offer the Holy Sacrifice in the rustic chapel of St. Paul, in the valley of the Willamette. These humble pioneer settlers have been unsung and unloved, but to them belongs the honor of establishing the first white settlement in Oregon.

Dr. John McLoughlin if not the first actual settler, must be regarded as the father of the settlement of Oregon. He induced the Canadians to begin the cultivation of the soil, was their guide and doctor, establishing a school for them, read-
