DETHRONED REASON.—James Sloan, of this city, was examined about 5 o'clock yesterday afternoon at the court house by county Judge Waldo and Drs. Richardson and Rowland and was committed to the asylum. Mr. Sloan was one of the early pioneers to Oregon and has been connected with some of the important public institutions. He was the first superintendent of the Oregon penitentiary, and was one at the head of the state insane asylum, when it was located in East Portland. He is 63 years old and is quite gray and age is telling its story. He has been in poor health for some time and his condition is attributed to inflammatory softening of the brain. At times he seems all right and at other times he is subject to falling fits and is unable to speak. He has been a nurse at the asylum for some time, but now must sacrifice his place as nurse to that of patient. The present attack was given in the examination of three weeks duration.

HAVE YOU SEEN HIM?—Hon. Napoleon Davis, clerk of the state land board, is in receipt of a letter from Mrs. Ida E. Cooper, of Alameda, Michigan, inquiring after her husband, Ferdinand K. Cooper, who left their Michigan home last spring and was last heard from at Box Alder, Utah, from which point he started westward in April with a team and wagon. Mr. Cooper is 49 years old, 5 feet 8 inches high, with blue eyes, brown hair and whiskers. He was evidently intent on buying land, as his wife writes to Mr. Davis inquiring if such a man had purchased or inquired for land at this office. NO MORE SHODDY JOBS.—It is as well to be just as generous in public matters. Salem people are also together too generous with frauds. The following from the Albany Democrat is to the point and reflects back upon a good deal of the sewer-building contracts in this city. The Democrat says: "Cheap things are not always the cheapest, a paradoxical saying. It doesn't pay to buy shoddy goods nor to simply think about what a thing is going to cost. This is true of sewers likewise. It will pay in the long run to have our sewers well constructed. We want no shoddy jobs, if a few cents are saved."

WHEEL BROKEN.—The main drive wheel at the Salem water works broke last night which will prevent them from using the water power for several days. This wheel weighs a ton and will be replaced by a new one made in San Francisco. Superintendent Martin telegraphed to San Francisco last night for the new wheel to be casted at once if the old model had not been destroyed. If the model has been preserved the casting can be done and the wheel be here in about a week. In the meantime the steam pumps will supply the works with the necessary power.

Good as guardian was presented and accepted, and Dr. Wm. Boys was chosen to fill the vacancy. F. Levy, as executor of the James Stanley estate, presented his amended final account, which was approved, and he was released from further duty; Alonzo Gesner was appointed trustee of the residue fund. In the estate of Solomon Mosier, a spendthrift, E. M. Hartman, the guardian, was retained in that position contrary to a petition presented asking for his dismissal.

PLANTING FRUIT TREES.—From the number of wagons seen passing through the streets loaded with fruit trees one would naturally infer that considerable land was being set out in fruit this fall. The weather has been all that could be desired for such work. Some prefer to plant their trees in the spring, while many consider the fall and early winter a better time to assure growth. This time of the year seems to meet the favor of the Oregon fruit growers for their planting. There is no question but that there will be more trees planted in the Willamette valley this year than during any previous one.

A KICK ON SHORT-WEIGHT BUTTER.—Pendleton grocersmen, also their customers are kicking. It appears that the honest farmer who sells butter frequently makes his rolls considerably underweight in order to more quickly pay off his mortgage. Two-pound rolls are found to weigh one and one half or one and three-quarter pounds, and the one-pound rolls are equally deceptive. The dealers say they are willing to pay good prices for butter, but want to receive all they pay for.—Ex.
