HOW BISMARCK FELL.

He appealed to the Empress Frederick to intercede for him, but in vain.

LONDON, Jan. 4.—The following account of the circumstances which brought about the resignation of Prince Bismarck is published in the Times this morning and is vouches for as accurate:

Frances now begins for the first time to understand Bismarck's fall, and the circumstances, unknown till of late, which accompanied it. All these revelations are such that the ex-Chancellor's bitterest enemies hardly venture to discuss what a shadow he casts in his descent from power.

those only whom his caprice invited

around him. He tolerated no ob-

jections, and listened with a con-

descending smile which condemned

beforehand the ideas submitted to

him by his young master, the Em-

peror.

He even ceased really to work,

while complaining bitterly of the

slightest decision was come to without

consulting him; and yet professed himself overwhelmed with la-

boration whenever documents were sent

to him to sign. He had become

terrible to all who were obliged to

come near him. Nobody ventured

to contradict him. Even Emperor

William II saw him only occasio-
