PAVING ORDINANCE. The ordinance for grading, paving, curbing, guttering and otherwise improving parts of Commercial, Court and State streets, was taken up and read. The reading required over half an hour, and taxed the aptitude of Recorder Goodell and City Attorney Richardson as readers.

It is an ably prepared document and required a vast amount of labor. It was got through with and Alderman Brown at once moved suspension of rules and the ordinance was read a second time by title only. General discussion then followed.

Alderman Murphy appeared for the first time and made only a few remarks to draw out information. On question of suspension of rules to read a third time, votes: Gray, Moores, Hutton, 3; ayes: Johnson, Lafore, Murphy, Brown, Lamoreaux, 5. The mayor ruled that the motion to suspend was lost, requiring an unanimous vote.

Mr. Gray called up amendment to Southern Pacific right of way ordinance on Front street, to allow the company to pack gravel between its rails instead of plank. The bill was passed to third reading.

Alderman Hutton said the way the company was putting the gravel down was very objectionable and the property owners were a unit against gravel.

Alderman Moores said the citizens on that street had only consented to allow the road to go down there on condition that the company plank the track between and on each side of the rails.

SALEM HUMANE SOCIETY. A Well Attended Meeting.—Committee Authorized to Work in the Schools.

There was a good attendance Tuesday, President A. Bush, chairman, Treasurer Ladue submitted a report showing \$36 on hand. The report was received and adopted.

Secretary Miss R. F. Hall submitted a report, which was read and adopted.

Dr. E. B. Philbrook became a member, and Miss Hall reported seven new members as received by her.

The society now has over fifty members.

There were present Miss Hall, Mrs. Wm. England, Mrs. E. Hofer, Mrs. Miner, Mrs. Edward Hirsch, Messrs. A. Bush, Seth Hammer, Dr. Philbrook, H. H. Smith, Rev. Brown and a JOURNAL reporter.

Mr. Bush stated that there had not been many prosecutions, the society had exerted a silent influence, and had a repressive effect upon the practice of cruelty to animals.

There had not been as much cruelty to horses the past season as before. Nearly all the members reported good effects as flowing from the organization. Several cases of cruelty were discussed and the public is requested to report to the members of the society any cases that occur.

A committee of four was appointed to secure the distribution of literature in the public schools, consisting of E. Hofer, H. H. Smith, Mrs. S. G. Miner, and Mrs. Edward Hirsch. Fifteen dollars was appropriated for the use of this committee. The plan of this committee is to confer with the board of education and teachers and through them make the objects of the society in humane reforms familiar to the young.

The society then adjourned.

BAKING POWDERS. What the Minnesota State Authorities Know About Them.

The Dairy and Food Commission and the state chemist are the highest official authorities upon such subjects in this state, and their evidence will be accepted as disinterested and unprejudiced. It is their business to examine the quality of the different food products, and to suppress the sale of those found impure and unwholesome, and all will admit that they have performed their duties without fear or favor.

At a recent examination by a legislative committee to determine the qualities of the various baking powders sold in Minnesota by State Chemist and analyst to the Food and Dairy Commissioner, Dr. Benjamin F. Drew, gave the following evidence:

Ques.—Dr. Drew, I see by the report of the Dairy and Food Commission of the state that in making analysis of the various baking powders of this country you report as a result of your work that the Royal Baking Powder contains and gives off in baking a greater per cent. of carbonic acid gas (leavening gas) than any other baking powder made, is that true?
