The Chilians Sentence the Rufians that Killed our Sailors

THE CHILIANS STILL AT IT.

THE SENTENCE PASSED.
NEW YORK, Feb. 5.—The Herald's special cablegram from Valparaiso, Chile, says: Judge of Crimes Foster yesterday passed sentence in the long-pending and much discussed Baltimore assault case of October 16, 1901. His sentence is subject to review by the court of appeals. The document covers 180 pages, and goes all over again the evidence against the accused and compares it closely with the evidence presented by the prisoners. The finding of the court is as follows: Carlos Arena and Alias James are sentenced to 540 days' imprisonment for wounding William Turnbull, the coal-heaver of the Baltimore, who died of his injuries, 300 days for disorder, sixty days for carrying a knife, and twenty days for giving an assumed name. Jose Roldan is sentenced to 320 days' imprisonment for injuring Turnbull. Frederic Roderigny is sentenced to thirteen days' imprisonment for wounding Boatwain Mate Charles W. Riggan another of the American seamen, for public disorder and for carrying a knife. It is held by Judge Foster that the evidence does not show that Roderigny did kill Riggan, on the contrary it is claimed that Riggan's death was caused by a shot which was fired by some unknown person. Gomez and Roderigny, under the Chilean penalties, must pay the families of Turnbull and Riggan damages. These damages are recoverable by civil suit. Congress will meet again in April.

CHILIANS STILL AT IT.
LONDON, Feb. 5.—The correspondent of The Times at Valparaiso says: The police guard at the house of Egan, United States minister at Santiago, is maintained by the Chilean authorities with a view of preventing any attack at the instance of the rough element. This fact the correspondent says threatens to bring about a reopening of the difficulty with the United States.

THE CHILIAN MOB.
VALPARAISO, Feb. 5.—The offices of Demagogue at Santiago, and Opedion at Valparaiso, have been cleaned out. These two newspapers are regarded as unfriendly to the present government. The former was attacked by a mob, and short work was made of the office. In the case of the latter, it is claimed that some military officers who were passing the office were insulted from the windows, and then assaulted with iron bars and pistol shots. They broke into the office, smashed the furniture, pried the type in the forms, and otherwise wrecked the office. Both papers, as well as La Republica, whose office was cleaned out Tuesday, issued small fly sheets Wednesday, protesting against the action of the mobs as a violation of the liberty of the press. Captain Gorin, the late commander of the Imperial under Balboa, has arrived here from Peru. He was arrested and placed on the gunboat O'Higgins. General Velasco is still a prisoner on board the cruiser Errazuriz.

ANOTHER FEUD.
PINEVILLE, Ky., Feb. 4.—The Turner and Parton factions have had another clash, and this time one of the Turner gang was killed. The man killed was George Sharp, a son of old Kirk Sharp, at whose house Turner and his gang had been making their headquarters. The encounter occurred on Sunday night, but no news was received here until Wednesday. Silas Parton, a cousin to Manuel Parton, who was killed, and who was with him at the time, brought the news here. The Partons who had kept a close watch on Turner, thought they saw an opportunity to catch the outlaw when his men were away from the house, so four of the Parton crowd made a sudden swoop on the rendezvous. They caught Turner and Sharp asleep in the cabin, as they had anticipated, and made them prisoners. Turner, however, made an outcry, which brought to his rescue a number of his men, who were in a cabin a short distance away. The Partons, seeing they were outnumbered, fled. A number of shots were exchanged, and George Sharp was killed. No further steps have been taken to organize a posse of officers here to capture Berry Turner, since it has been learned that the seat of the trouble is in Tennessee and not in Kentucky.

DANGEROUS PLAYTHING.
ELMIRA, Cal., Feb. 5.—While the 7-year-old son of Mrs. Parks, who lives ten miles east of this place, was playing with gunpowder, he placed some on the table upon which was a six-pound can of powder, and touched it with a lighted match, causing it to ignite the powder in the can, which exploded and badly wrecked the entire building, severely burning the face and hands of three children.

A LAW QUESTION.

WALLA WALLA, Feb. 5.—The jury in the case of the state vs. Henry Hanes, for committing rape on the 16-year-old daughter of Conrad Ott, returned a verdict of guilty. When the judge charged the jury he instructed them that he would receive a verdict up to 10 o'clock. The jury arrived at a verdict at 2 in the morning, and dispersed to their homes. When they came to the court the judge scored them and the bailiff for the action. After the verdict was read, Hanes' attorney moved for a new trial, on the grounds that the jury had dispersed after arriving at a verdict, which was contrary to the instructions of the court. This case will probably raise an important law question, to be decided by the courts.

REED TALKS.
WASHINGTON, Feb. 5.—Talking yesterday afternoon to an Associated Press reporter, ex-Speaker Reed said: "The withdrawal by the Louisiana Lottery company of its demand for a new charter is one of the triumphs of the fifty-first congress. Now that the supreme court has sustained the constitutionality of the anti-lottery postal act, even the lottery company recognizes the futility of further resistance. The acts of the fifty-first congress shall stand well the test of time. With regard to the rules just adopted Reed said that the principle of responsibility in the government of the house has been more ruthlessly recognized in that part of the new regulations regarding the power of the committee on rules than has ever dreamed of in the fifty-first congress. The power to enforce the will of the house was lodged in important measures in that committee, so that party legislation could have full swing, while the bill of an individual member, even if approved by the house, is at the mercy of the filibuster. The right of a present quorum has been denied, and the force of a member present for a purpose absent, has been revived. All this, however, fine and the supreme court will take care of. Meanwhile, it will be a source of regret to the country that more liberal measures for the promotion in innocent, useful, non-partisan, and necessary legislation were not adopted."

SAN FRANCISCO POSTOFFICE.
WASHINGTON, Feb. 5.—The commission having in charge the matter of the selection and purchase of a site of a public building at San Francisco, consisting of the postmaster-general, the secretary of the treasury and the attorney-general, met today and decided upon the purchase of the Seventh and Mission street property. The purchase will not be consummated until every effort has been made against the local commission. A special agent of the treasury has been investigating the matter. Thus far he has not discovered anything tangible upon which adverse action can be taken. The commission today ordered the publication, through the public press, of a request that any person or persons having knowledge of bribes having been received by the local commission, to communicate to the general commission at Washington. As to the Jesse-street site the postmaster-general said a question of title had arisen which the authorities of San Francisco had been obliged to pass upon before any action in that case could be taken.

IT IS DYING.
NEW ORLEANS, Feb. 1.—J. A. Morris, of the Louisiana Lottery company, yesterday issued a lengthy address to the people of Louisiana, setting forth the facts in connection with lottery matters. He says in '83 he was approached by a number of prominent Democrats of Louisiana, who urged on him the propriety of submitting to the legislature a proposition for a constitutional amendment which would grant him and his associates the lottery privilege for twenty-five years in consideration of a license sufficiently high to be of material assistance to the state. He was assured that the proposition would meet with little if any opposition, and these suggestions prompted him to make an announcement to the fact that he would give \$500,000 per annum as a license. After the Mississippi floods, at the solicitation of a number of gentlemen he increased the amount to \$1,250,000. The amendment was passed by the legislature, and thus was submitted to the people. Then began a crusade inside and outside the state, which resulted in the enactment by congress of an anti-lottery postal law. Morris says he was informed by a number of able attorneys that this law was a violation of the rights of the state and the freedom of the press, and as such in their opinion would be the decision of the supreme court of the United States.

Realizing now that they have been incorrect in their opinion of public sentiment, and not desiring to see the people of Louisiana involved in strife over the question, Morris declares they would not accept or qualify under the amendment, even were it to be adopted by the people in April next. As the supreme court of the United States decided the anti-lottery law to be unconstitutional, it is his purpose to uphold that law and abstain from violating it in any manner. Confident that the granting of another lottery charter would be the cause of continued agitation and discontent on the part of a number of citizens of Louisiana, he and his associates would be unwilling to accept such a charter, even though it was given without the payment of one dollar license.

FAIR COMMISSION.
CHICAGO, Feb. 5.—The world's fair conference committee, representing the local directory and the national commission, has drawn up the bill for congressional aid. An important feature, and one that will cause a big row here, is that no sum is specified. The members from the local body are agreed that, in view of the feeling in congress and the differences between some of the directors and some of the members of the national board of control, to ask for \$5,000,000 would be suicidal. Congress will be asked to appropriate an amount to be determined by that body on recommendation of the national commission.

REAL MAD DOG.
PORTLAND, Feb. 5.—A mad dog ran into a candy store on Third street yesterday and frightened a great many people. He darted at everything within reach, knocking the glass and jars of the soda fountain. The girls behind the counter were scared almost to death, and ran all over the store, jumping over tables and chairs. Several people in the restaurant expected every moment to have the dog jump at them, and he did run at several, but did not bite any one. A large crowd collected outside and peered in. The doors of the place were locked up to keep him from getting into the street. But as he did not become calm, the back door was thrown open and he flew out. Since it is not known what has become of him. The damage in the restaurant amounted to about \$15 or \$20.

RAISED HILLS.
PORTLAND, Feb. 5.—Mr. Stolz, of the firm of C. M. Prozman & Co., wholesale liquor dealers, took in a \$10 bill from a friend, but at once detected that it was raised from \$2, and his friend is \$8 out, as he could not recollect where he had received the bill. The note is a genuine \$2 bill, but wherever the figures 2 are shown, they are pasted over with the figures ten cut from a common internal revenue stamp, found on cigarette packages. The small figures two around the border of the bill are crossed out with ink, and the letters "wo" in the main part of the note are covered with the letters "en."

PEOPLE'S PARTY.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 5.—The People's party of the house of representatives is intact as to party members. In the caucus which met before the organization of the house, the nine independent representatives decided to preserve their political autonomy on all questions to the end of the session. Within the past few days various reports of alleged disaffection in the ranks of the independent representatives have been current, and they complained last night that these rumors were inspired by politicians of other parties and telegraphed throughout the country for political effect. They therefore determined to issue an address to the country, in which they say at no meeting was any motion or suggestion made that the Alliance should join the Democratic party or cast their lot with it. A disagreement occurred because certain Alliance congressmen thought the contest should be made through old parties, and others that independent action was necessary. There has been no split and each member still believed in independent political action.

THE HOUSE YESTERDAY.
WASHINGTON, Feb. 5.—The house of representatives was called before the bar of public opinion yesterday to answer to the charge of irreverence to the memory of departed representatives. Stout, of Michigan, was public prosecutor, and in absence of counsel, the house pleaded guilty to the charge.

The first declaration of the inconstancy of such proceedings came from Enloe, of Tennessee, who desired to amend the rules by providing that eulogies of deceased members shall be delivered on Sundays only, on which day the ceremonies shall be opened with prayer by the chaplain. The amendment was seconded by Morse (Mass.).

"I am in favor of this amendment," said Mr. Stout. "I happened once, Mr. Speaker, to be in St. Louis when the funeral cortege of a member of congress passed through that city. The newspapers next morning said the body was left in the depot, while the senators were talking about the preceding election in the rotunda of the hotel (laughter), and the young members were gone to the theater, I suppose to assuage their profound grief (great laughter). The country should know whether or not we are sincere in our professions of respect to the dead."

Reed of Maine, gave information that the consumption of time in the first session of the last congress for memorial services was twenty-four days. This announcement created great surprise, but was not disputed. Although a standing vote showed a majority of 96 to 68 in favor of the amendment, this majority vanished before the dreaded roll call, and the amendment was defeated 91 to 159.

Chipman of Michigan, offered an amendment providing for Friday night sessions for the consideration of private pension bills; agreed to.

The consideration of the rules reported by the committee having been concluded, Reed, on behalf of the Republicans, offered as a substitute the rules of the Fifty-first congress, but it was lost without division.

The code of rules was then adopted.

WALKER'S GRAVE.

PORTLAND, Feb. 5.—John Darrah, a telegraph operator known throughout the Northwest, has been all over Central America and the Nicaragua country. He has been chief in several offices of the Western Union, and is probably the only man in the United States who knows the exact spot of the grave of General Walker, the man who attempted to capture Nicaragua in 1858.

He came down from Seattle recently and left for Pendleton, from which point he will probably go to Helena and make that his home for some time to come. His health has been very bad on the road, so that he wanted to get into a dryer climate. In Central America he located the telegraph line following the Nicaragua canal.

By his relations to the governments of the different states he became well acquainted with the fields. And he is one of the only two besides the government officials who know where the body of General Walker is buried. General Walker, as is now a matter of history, organized an expedition in the South, which shipped from New Orleans in '58 with the intention of capturing the Nicaragua countries.

But the attempt failed, and Walker and his first lieutenant were sentenced to be shot. The others were pardoned. The first lieutenant escaped, but the general was shot by the government of Honduras.

"I saw the very spot where Walker's body lies," said Mr. Darrah, "and with the exception of Consul Milhoad at Truxillo, from the English government, I am the only person besides the government officials who knows where the body lies."

It is in the native cemetery at Truxillo. There is no monument to mark his last resting place. One of the large mahogany trees, so plentiful in that country, lies across the grave.

"This is the only tree in the small cemetery and Walker was buried at its foot. Twelve years ago it fell from age, and is crosswise of the body. He was probably buried under this tree so that it could be known to those who should know the place."

THE WORLD'S FAIR.
CHICAGO, Feb. 5.—The Chicago directory of the world's fair have concluded that they can run their part of the great exposition without any financial help from Uncle Sam. Congress will not be asked to loan or appropriate a dollar for the local directory. All the funds needed to complete buildings and grounds in readiness to turn over to the president and national commission will be supplied by Chicago bankers and capitalists, who, it is said, have already guaranteed to make good any possible deficit. Congress will, however, be given a bill for consideration which will provide for an appropriation of about \$4,000,000, to be handled entirely by the national commission. This plan of legislation was finally decided upon yesterday at a conference between the directory committee and Chairman St. Clair of the national commission.
