THE DEEMING MURDER.

More Details of the Rainhill Horrible Crime.

LIVERPOOL, March 30.—Dr. Hutchinson, one of the medical men who conducted the post mortem examination of the bodies of Mrs. Deeming and her four children, which were found buried under the floor at Dinham Villa, Rainhill, said to a representative of the Associated Press that the crime disclosed calculating wickedness and heartless savagery almost beyond belief. The work of the murderer expert shows that only in one case was the stroke causing death more than sufficient for the purpose. Each stroke severed the vital organs and no more might have been accomplished by a surgeon or butcher who knew his business well. The mother and children had partaken of their evening meal. The mother was first called into the room where the murderer was awaiting her, and it appears as she stooped to untie her shoe she was attacked from behind, and died almost without a struggle. Then the children were called one by one to meet their death. Bertha, the eldest, had her thumbs tied behind her back and a similar bandage wound twice around her head, so as to cover her mouth and keep her from crying. A pillow case was placed over her head and the murderer strangled her. The hands of the second girl were also tied behind her back, but in the case of the other children this operation was not thought necessary. One other significant and sinister fact is that although the throats of four out of five of the victims were cut, on none of the bodies or clothing was there a trace of blood.

A REIGN OF TERROR.

Inhabitants of Paris Are Excited Over the Anarchists' Threats.

Both expressed themselves delighted with the moral effect of the explosion, which, they said, would direct greater attention to their doctrines.

STORMS IN CAL. AND NEV.

CARSON, Nev., March 29.—Rain set in this morning and continued all day. At 6 o'clock this evening it was still falling heavily. Weather service promises the heaviest storm of the year.

MARYSVILLE, Cal., March 29.—Rain and a strong south wind began early this morning and lasted until late this afternoon, when the wind subsided and the rain ceased.

SAN RAFAEL, Cal., March 29.—The heaviest storm of the season has been raging for the past twenty-four hours. The wind has got so great a force that large trees have been uprooted, and fences and signs innumerable have been blown down. The oldest settlers state that the storm of the last twenty-four hours has been the severest experienced in their recollection. Crop prospects here have never been so promising.

DUNSMUIR, Cal., March 29.—After several days of raining, a heavy snowstorm commenced last night and continued until late this afternoon. Over a foot of snow has fallen in the town, and several feet has fallen higher up in the mountains. Peach and some other fruit trees are in bloom, but no fears of damage are entertained.

RENO, Nev., March 29.—The wind is howling down the usually quiet Truckee river and the air is heavily laden with mountain dust. The weather is cold and disagreeable, and if one can go by the judgment of the oldest inhabitant, the worst storm of the season is following.

Drowned at Oregon City.

OREGON CITY, March 30.—Special to JOURNAL: Tom Scollard, a married man and Frank Perkins were drowned here this afternoon by being swept over a dam forty feet high. The two men were working in a skiff near the brink of the basin and the high waves caused by a steamer going from the basin crowded a boom against the skiff in which the men were at work over the dam. The men or boat never came to the surface.

The Chicago Boodlers.

CHICAGO, March 30.—State Attorney Longenecker today struck the reporter, M. H. Salt, engaged in writing up the boodler business. Salt was the author of an article in his paper charging Longenecker with being a boodler himself, and afraid to push the cases against the boodlers. Longenecker threatens a criminal libel suit, and the reporter threatens to arrest Longenecker.

Signals Misunderstood.

MONTREY, March 30.—The tug Fearless has arrived here from San Francisco having seen nothing of the British man-of-war Warspite, for which she was in search. It is now believed the Warspite's signals were misunderstood and that she is in need of assistance. It is supposed the vessel has proceeded on her way North.

Gilbert Sworn In.

PORTLAND, March 30.—United States District Judge Deady today administered the oath of office to W. B. Gilbert, recently appointed judge of the circuit court of appeals for the ninth judicial circuit.

The Boyd-Thayer Case.

LINCOLN, Neb., March 30.—Argument was made before the supreme court yesterday in support of the motion for the reopening of the Boyd-Thayer case. A decision is expected today.

ACTED FOR THE BEST.

England was Guarding the Interests of Its Subjects.

LONDON, March 30.—In the house of commons, Edward Gourley asked whether the government, before refusing the request of the United States for a renewal of the modus vivendi, had under consideration the dispatch of Sir Baden-Powell, British commissioner, stating a renewal of the prohibition against indiscriminate sealing and limiting the catch to 75,000 would be beneficial; if so, why the policy thus indicated had been followed. James W. Lowther, parliamentary secretary of the foreign office, replied it was incorrect to say the government had refused to consent to a renewal of the modus vivendi. Sir Baden-Powell had said that in his opinion the taking of a year's limited crop could not injure the seal herds, but a renewal of last year's prohibition and the 75,000 limit would be beneficial although unnecessary. That policy, Lowther declared, was being followed subject to conditions considered necessary by the home government in the interests of British subjects engaged in sealing. Lowther's statement was greeted with cheers.

STORM IN CALIFORNIA.

A Lively Gale on San Francisco Bay and Its Results.

SAN FRANCISCO, March 30.—The heaviest gale of the year raged in San Francisco bay yesterday. The Oakland steamers were almost derided, and several of the ships moved into the stream. The American ship Jatez Howes arrived after a splendid passage of 120 days from Honolulu, but the Vigilant could not get her past Goat Island on account of the southeaster. At 6 o'clock a. m. it was blowing twenty-eight miles an hour; at 9 a. m., forty-six miles an hour, and at noon, fifty-four miles, and still increasing. At 2:30 the wind was blowing at sixty-two miles an hour and the barometer falling rapidly. Several ships dragged their anchors, but were caught by the tugs.

U. P. TELEGRAPH.

It Must Operate Its Own Lines Hereafter.

WASHINGTON, March 30.—Justice Brewer, of the supreme court, sitting as judge of the circuit court of the district embracing Nebraska, has rendered a decision declaring illegal the contract under which the telegraph lines of the Union Pacific railroad are operated by the Western Union, and directs the road hereafter to operate its own lines.

LOST HER RUDDER.

Steamer Keweenaw in Tow of Tug Relief.

SAN FRANCISCO, March 30.—A dispatch from Point Reyes light house, states that the steamer Keweenaw, from Seattle, passed there this morning, in tow of the tug Relief and bound for this city. Keweenaw had lost her rudder.

THE CHARGE DISMISSED.

Thomas Scott, an Old Pioneer, Goes Without Punishment.

PORTLAND, March 30.—Thomas Scott, an old and well known pioneer of Oregon, was arrested by a deputy United States marshal at Galloway's, Morrow county, on a charge of opening letters that did not belong to him. Scott is postmaster at Galloway's, and these two letters passed through his hands. They were addressed to different persons. Scott was taken to Pendleton and arraigned before United States Commissioner Bean. At the preliminary examination Scott declared that he had opened these letters, but the evidence to the contrary was very strong. However, the persons whose letters it was claimed had been opened did not wish to press the charge against the defendant, and the case was dismissed. Scott is a very old man and has resided for a great many years in Oregon. He has been the Nasby Galloway's for some time, has always borne a good character and is highly respected. He lived in Clatsop county away back in the pioneer days and was a member of the territorial legislature. The dismissal of the charge meets with general public approval.

WASHINGTON, March 30.—Senator Dolph on the committee on foreign relations introduced a bill to provide for the punishment of violations of treaty right of aliens. The bill was suggested by the Italian troubles at New Orleans last year.

Raum Investigation.

WASHINGTON, March 30.—Examination of Pension Commissioner Raum resumed. In the investigation Raum said he secured the dismissal of Clerk Edward Reud because he believed him the author of attacks on the commissioner through the New York Tribune.

Hotel Burned.

BOSTON, March 30.—Clark's hotel was damaged \$30,000 by fire early this morning. Guests were panic-stricken and some jumped from the windows. Several are seriously, and one or two probably fatally, hurt.

More Details of the Australian "Jack The Ripper."

THE FREE SILVER QUESTION.

It Will Be Transferred to the Senate Monday.

WASHINGTON, March 30.—The notice in the senate yesterday afternoon by Stewart of intention to call up his free coinage silver bill Monday created a sensation, notwithstanding the fact it was expected, in view of the set-back the Bland bill received in the house, that the struggle must sooner or later be resumed in the senate. As far as can be learned Stewart appears to have acted on his own responsibility in precipitating the issue. It is said by some silver men that Speaker Crisp urged them to pass the silver bill in the senate, and let it come over to the house when it would be in a position much more favorable for action if it came before the house from the coinage committee. Some Republican silver senators are unable to see the force of this reasoning. They fear the speaker is playing for a party advantage which might be expected to follow the passage of the silver bill by the Republican senate even by the instrumentality of Democratic votes. The Democratic senators are as yet undecided as to the attitude they shall assume when the bill is called up by Stewart. Carlisle remarked that the outcome of the effort to pass the bill was extremely doubtful. This view appears to be generally entertained on this side of the chamber. There will probably be a general consultation among the Democratic senators before Monday for the purpose of reaching an agreement upon a united line of action. The Republican side are of the opinion the bill will not pass. Hansbrough, of South Dakota, who has been included in all estimates in the ranks of the silver men, said very frankly yesterday afternoon he would oppose with his vote an effort to pass a pure free coinage bill, and believed that not ten Republican senators would vote for such a bill. He called attention to the fact that the successor of Plumb in the senate, was an anti-free coinage man and he felt confident that even with the full strength which the Democratic silver senators had shown in the last struggle the bill would not have more than one majority. As a matter of fact, he believed the Democrats were divided on the question, and he expected when it came to a test vote, many of them who formerly voted for the Vest bill will vote against the Stewart bill. Stewart himself is not very sanguine of the success of his move. He says, however, the country is entitled to know exactly how the senators stand on the silver question, and he proposes to put them on record if he can.

ROUTING IN PRAGUE.

Interdicted Meetings Broken Up by the Police.

PRAGUE, March 30.—In spite of the interdiction by the government, the native Czechs gathered in great numbers Monday night to celebrate the anniversary of the birth of John Comenius, a distinguished seventeenth century educational reformer. The police charged the crowd with drawn swords. The latter resisted with sticks, and were only dispersed after a desperate battle and many arrests. The crowd assembled at another point, denounced Minister of Education Gausch and cheered again and another battle ensued resulting like the former. The crowd then started for the Jewish quarter to wreak vengeance on the Hebrews. On the road they were met by a detachment of the mounted police. Refusing to turn back, the police spurred their horses into the crowd, slashing right and left with swords. They met a stubborn resistance, and it was only after drawing off, re-forming and making a second charge that the rioters were put to rout, very many of them with severe sword wounds or injuries caused by being trampled upon by the horses. They were removed to the hospitals and their wounds dressed, and then locked up. No further trouble is feared.

COLUMBIA LIGHT SHIP.

For the Mouth of the Columbia River—Two White Lights.

PORTLAND, March 30.—Notice has been issued by the lighthouse board that on April 15th, or as soon after that as possible, light-vessel No. 50 will be moored in 180 feet at low water of the entrance to the Columbia river. The vessel will show two fixed white reflector lights, each thirty feet above sea level, visible in clear weather from the deck of a vessel fifteen feet above the sea ten and a half nautical miles.

SPRINGER'S WOOL BILL.

Speculation As to What Will Eventually Become of the Measure.

WASHINGTON, March 30.—The Springer free-wool bill will probably be passed by the house and sent to the senate within a week. This is the program discussed at a series of consultations between the speaker and the Democratic members of the ways and means committee. It will probably receive a formal endorsement of the Democratic majority of the committee tomorrow, and the house at the proper time will be requested to give concurrence by agreeing to a suspension of the rules for the passage of the bill. In assenting to the project Springer advised the members of the committee of what his physicians said concerning his health.
