He also heard from a fruit-grower on the Washington side of the Columbia, that the orchards near Vancouver were badly injured. It is known that orchards in Southern Oregon suffered greatly, the exception being in favor of the hill sides near Ashland. It is also true that the same frost, April 12th, did much harm in California. Mr. Clarke says that he sees no evidence of frost in his orchard, and thinks that while fruit on the prairie has suffered somewhat the red hills are all right. 
