THE GRIPMAN EXONERATED

In Case of Killing Brunswick by a Cable Car.

CHICAGO, Dec. 21.—Duputy Coroner Barrett has recommended in his report on the body of E. Brunswick, of San Francisco, killed by a cable-car. Coroner McHale is determined that in every case of death from a cable-car accident, a most thorough investigation shall be made, as he believes the public's duty is interested in knowing where the blame properly rests in these affairs. The coroner therefore visited the inquest. Brunswick's friends have been badly engaged looking into the exact facts. Friday the inquest was commenced, but was continued, as was developed this morning, because of a statement made by Alderman Woodard to an officer that the street car company had four witnesses it would not produce. J. B. Levi, a traveling salesman, testified that he was standing on the corner nearest Brunswick as he stepped from the sidewalk. The attention of witness was called to the fact that Brunswick did not appear to see the approaching train. The grip came around the curve within five or six feet of the man, and Levi called to him. At the same time, the gripman also yelled, and commenced to ring the bell. Brunswick started backward, but before he could get entirely out of the way was knocked down. Witness stated among other significant facts that when the gripman rang the bell Brunswick was three feet from the track, and the ringing commenced when the grip was half way around the curve. George Sennot, another witness, was crossing the street at the time of the accident. He passed in the rear of the train as it turned the curve into Madison street. He saw a man stretch out his hand to get on or endeavoring to avoid the car he could not say. He saw him lose his balance and fall, seemingly between the grip and the first car, the latter dragging him some distance. Dr. Hunt, who also witnessed the accident, stated his idea at the time was the man who had been struck by the unnoticed grip as it bore down upon him at the curve. All the witnesses testified Brunswick was the only person on the crossing at the time. The jury in their verdict found death was accidental, exonerated the gripman, and recommended the street car company either to run cars around the corner in question at a slow rate of speed, or to station a man at that corner while the cars are running. The verdict was reached without the company having produced the witness whose absence occasioned the postponement of Friday.

GREAT TROTTER SOLD.

Stamboul Bought by a New York Banker.

NEW YORK, Dec. 21.—The lovers of trotters commenced to gather at the American Institute building to attend the sale which should mark the disposal of the Holbart stud. The star of the collection was Stamboul, the stallion king, with a record of 2:07. Breeders from many sections of the country were among those who gathered early to determine whose property the king should be. The champion was shown a score of times, and the universal opinion was that he was a horse of superb individuality, symmetrical proportions, and a trotter worthy to be at the top of the tree. Soon after 10 o'clock, while the noted stallion was being moved about the ring, the bidding began. It started with \$30,000, and went up slowly with jumps of \$500 and \$1,000, until it reached \$39,000. Then the bidding stopped awhile, and Stamboul was trotted around the ring several times. Then there was a bid of \$40,000, and that was followed by the closing bid of \$41,000. The purchaser is D. H. Harriman, a banker of this city. Five minutes after Stamboul was sold, Corson, one of the executors of the Holbart estate, said he would give Harriman \$5,000 to withdraw the bid, but Harriman had then left the building.

Burned to Death.

ALBANY, N. Y., Dec. 21.—A special from Warrensburg says: "Phillippe Harris, of Scroon Lake, teacher of vocal music and a local Methodist preacher, was burned to death here. J. S. Woodward, Louis Gouthay and Howard Branch were also seriously burned, the latter probably fatally. The men were removing furniture from the burning residence of J. S.
