When the Spectator's friend reached London all of the talk was of the coming opening of the Crystal palace. The royalties were to be there in great force, to say nothing of mere celebrities.

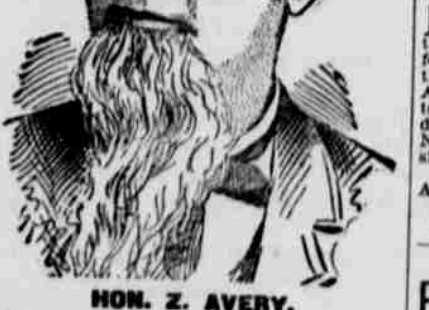

A QUAINY SCENE IN GOTHAM. Friday Afternoon Marketing in the Heart of the Jewish Quarter. Between Grand street and East Broadway Norfolk street is one of the most picturesque thoroughfares of the city.

Nearly all are occupied by bakers, and the proprietors can be seen hustling around attending to their customers with their sleeves rolled up above their elbows and their persons and clothes covered with flour.

The street is filled with children from toddling infants to boys and girls twelve and thirteen years old. Very few boys above the age of thirteen can be seen at play, because after a Jewish boy arrives at the age of thirteen he is supposed to have taken on man's estate, and with it the cares and dignity of a man.

Other interesting features of Norfolk street are the tobacco stores and stands. Cigars are not as prominent in the display as in ordinary places, but the long cut Turkish and Russian tobacco for cigarette and pipe use appear to be most popular.
