THE ORATORICAL CONTEST. There are differences of opinion as to who should have received the medal at the state oratorical contest. But there is little difference of opinion as to the award that was made. It is totally unsatisfactory except to the winners. It was excelled in delivered language, no matter how it may have appeared in writing, by McIntosh of Menmouth. It was one of the two least dramatically presented. It was one of the three least entertaining. On any sort of careful scoring it could not have ranked more than third among the performances of the evening. By all good tests of oratory the medal belonged to Monmouth or Eugene.

Hon. G. M. Irwin, who was one of the Republican presidential electors last fall, was in Pendleton on Friday, says the Tribune.
