GIVE US A STRAIGHT ISSUE.

The Republican party will learn that it cannot beat the Populist party in the advocacy of its own principles. This is the lesson of the election. Oregon, after all, is a gold standard, not a silver standard, state, and this will be established when we get a straight issue on the question.—The Oregonian.

The above is copied in the eastern press as the utterance of a reliable Republican paper. It is believed by the delegates sent from Oregon to the Republican national convention—heavy weights like the young man Wallace McCannan, a youth hardly dry behind the ears and has never been released from Grandmother Scott's apron strings.

Harvey Scott says the fact that Oregon is for the gold standard will be established whenever a straight issue on that question can be had. The votes cast for other than sound money candidates at the recent election were 55,000 as against 27,000 for the sound money candidates. Does that look as though when in November all the silver votes were united on one candidate for the presidency, Oregon would elect a gold standard man?

On a square issue between a candidate who stands for bimetalism and a reasonable tariff for American industries and one who represents the gold standard and protection. Oregon would give a plurality of 20,000 for bimetalism and protection. We do not believe that Scott is honest in wanting a square issue made between gold and silver. If there was any prospect of a square fight on that issue he and his cohorts would move heaven and earth to run stalking horse candidates to divide the silver vote.

At Union, the other day, Judge Lowell sentenced James Robbins to 35 years in the Salem penitentiary for rape. Last spring, at Baker City, Judge Eakin sentenced a man for the same crime to 99 years in the penitentiary.
