STATE NEWS.

Grants Pass has a boy's band of twenty pieces.

There are sixteen applicants for the postoffice in Eugene.

Albany is having a chrysanthemum show of three days duration.

Charles Wilson, of Newberg, is making a collection of campaign buttons.

Dr. Davis, of Harrisburg, last Saturday sold his crop of hops, 138 bales at 104 cents per pound.

The enrollment in the public school at Newberg is 263 and the pupils are divided between 6 teachers.

The Forest Grove postoffice will be made an international money order office the first of the year.

The Dallas streets are in darkness at night. The electric company's price for street lamps is more than the council is willing to pay.

There is a proposition before the city council at Portland to use gas and the old fashioned oil lamps for streets in the interest of economy.

Six members of the Eugene Salvation Army have repudiated the management in that city and from now on will their welfare in the hands of the Lord.

Elda Woods, recently convicted of robbing a mail stage on the Coos bay road, has been allowed a new trial by U. S. District Judge Bellinger, set for December 1st.

Hon. L. F. Lane, of Roseburg, who was once elected to congress from Oregon and has been a prominent Democratic politician, is dying from consumption.

The Pacific distillery of Grants, Sherman county which has been shut down for over a year, will resume again, owing to McKinley's election, says its manager.

The U. S. grand jury has indicted John Scanlan for passing counterfeit gold \$5 pieces at Waterloo, Linn county, and also John Carty, for writing an obscene letter to Michael Flynn a Rancher at Ridgefield, Wash.

C. S. Newell has been indicted by the state grand jury for stealing a watch valued at \$50 from Robert Pugh of Salem, while the latter was taking in the sights. He is also indicted for stealing morphine from Watson's drug store.

Ed. Johnson has brought suit in the United States court against the Clatsop Mills Company for \$4,500 for defamation of character. He was a teamster for the company and was accused of stealing oats, which was not proven on him.

It is already interesting. The McMinnville Telephone Register says: Two days after the election two enterprising citizens of Amity were in McMinnville looking up the members of the court house ring for signatures to their petitions for the Amity post-office.

Judgement has been awarded J. B. Montgomery for \$46,405 against the Northern Pacific Railroad Company, the sum being the price paid for 3,000 acres of land, together with interest, the land having been purchased in 1875, and the company not having a valid title at the time.

H. B. Morse, of The Dalles, the Chronicle says, has had his head shaved as smooth as a billiard ball, so that his forehead runs nearly back to his collar; and all because Mr. Morse, who is a Republican, had doubts of McKinley's election.
