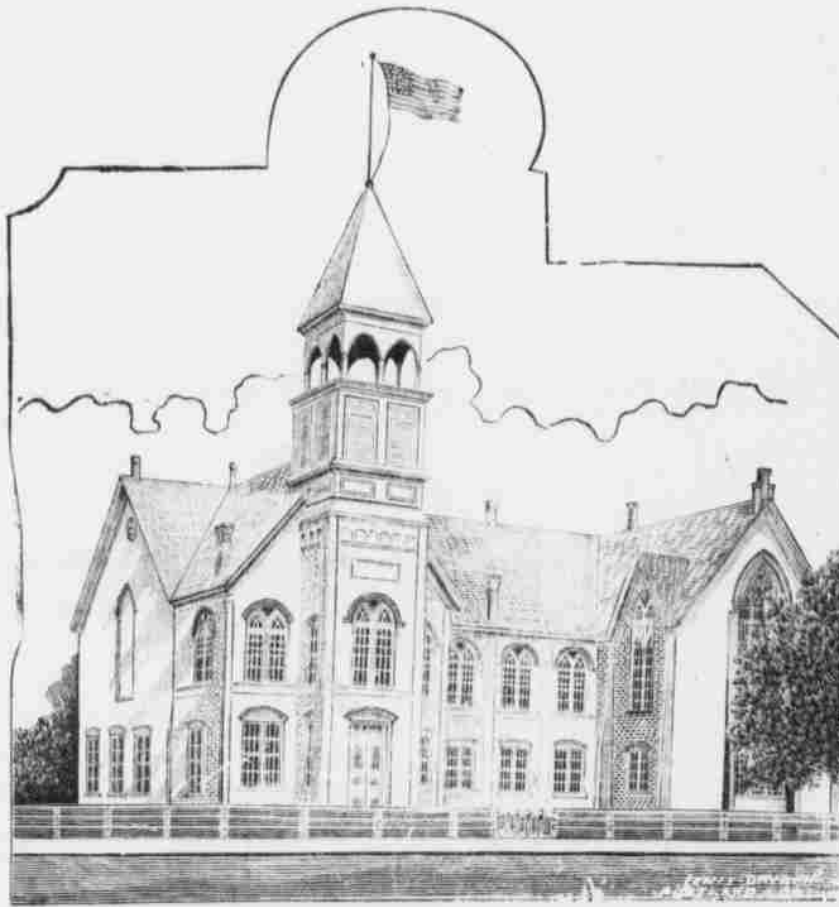
MARION COUNTY COURT HOUSE.
