Almost a Tragedy.

ST. LOUIS, Jan. 19.—Charles F. Simmons, reputed Millionaire and president of the Simmons Patent Medicine Company, shot Emil Dayton, bookkeeper of the St. Louis Trust Company, Simmons, who is an elderly, gray-haired man, met Dayton on the street, passed by him, heard angry words and the next instant Simmons drew a revolver and fired five times, each taking effect. Dayton dropped to the sidewalk seriously wounded, but still recoverable.

Simmons was placed under arrest. He told Captain Boyd that the man who had betrayed his daughter, and he had avenged the wrong done to his daughter.

This is Simmons' third deadly affray. Several years ago he stabbed his brother-in-law in Mississippi. Three years ago he stabbed his bookkeeper, a man named McBrain in a quarrel.

WASHINGTON NEWS.

Will Maintain Her Rights.

LONDON, Jan. 19.—The country generally is greatly pleased by the announcement made by the chancellor of the exchequer, Sir Michael Hicks-Beach, at Swansea, Monday night, in which he repeated the previous declaration of Edward and Matthew, on the Indian policy of the government, and added that the ministry was determined even at the cost of war that Chinese commerce should not be closed to great Britain.

This declaration is taken as outlining the government's position, and both liberal and conservative newspapers command the plain speaking.

Fatal Accident.

WILLIAMS, Ariz., Jan. 19.—An accident occurred at the Fairview tunnel nine miles west of here, in which one man was killed and one fatally injured. A number of others had an almost miraculous escape.

Sparks from the engine of a passenger train ignited the timbers in the roof of the tunnel. A gang of men was quickly dispatched from this city under Foremen Matthews and Parker. The men fought the flames all last night.

When the flames were all but out, the men were alarmed by a loud crash. In another moment a solid mass of rock and burning timbers came falling down. Roadmaster Lyons and Foreman Matthews were caught under the mass of rocks and timbers. They were soon taken out, but Lyon died in a few minutes, and it is not believed Matthews will live until morning.

No through trains will be able to pass through the tunnel for several days, as it is a sheet of fire from end to end. Passengers are being transferred around the mountain through the snow.

To Meet.

SAN FRANCISCO, Jan. 19.—Boxing is to be revived in San Francisco during February. The board of supervisors has granted the Empire Club to permit for a boxing show some time during next month. Applications from several other clubs for permits were before the board, but all were rejected.

The Empire Club will bring off a 20-round go between Joe Chynski and Tom Tunney, the Australian. The preliminary bout will be between Tom Lansing and Henry Baker.

The managers of the club, which have been left out in the cold are somewhat at a loss to understand why their applications should have been rejected and the Empire Club favored. The Occidental Club made application for a 20-round contest between Peter Jackson and Peter Maher, but were unsuccessful.
