Pearl Boyd's Life.

A Journal Reporter Visits Her in the County Jail.

Pearl Enjoys Being Incarcerated—She is an Item of Much Expense to the Taxpayers.

For the past ten days the Marion county jail has contained a inmate in the person of Pearl Boyd, the Gypsy girl, who is well-versed in crime for one so young in years.

Pearl made her debut in local police circles on October 28, when she sought protection of the police from the family with which she had been living, alleging that she had been abducted from her eastern home while a child.

In addition to the expense involved in the proceedings related above, all of which was met by individual subscribers by those interested in the girl, Pearl has been an item of considerable expense to the taxpayers of this county.

On Christmas Eve a number of articles of clothing belonging to Ruth Gabrielson were stolen from the First Methodist church and suspicion was fastened upon Pearl, who appeared the following day attired in the missing clothing.

Nothing further was heard of the girl until Sunday evening Jan. 16, when she appeared upon the streets dressed in male attire.

Justice Johnson not having yet made out his cost bill in this case. Pearl's sentence of 124 days expired at noon today when she was discharged only to be re-arrested on a warrant issued out of police court charging her with the larceny of an umbrella.

PEARL VISITED. Through the courtesy of Sheriff F. T. Wrightman, a JOURNAL reporter was last evening granted a short interview with the girl, Pearl, located in the north-east corner of the court house.

Notwithstanding the fact the girl's brother had brought her dresses and other articles of her clothing, she has persisted in donning the man's clothes in which she was dressed when arrested.

"How do I employ my time? Well I sing and whistle and converse with those passing in the street." The writer inquired if anyone had called to see her since her incarceration.

"What do you expect to do when you have served your time?" the writer inquired. "Oh, I don't know. That is of fact-way, that is most too far into the future. I would not like to say for fear I might tell a lie."

The reporter then referred to the fact that her sentence would expire at noon today and of her subsequent discharge, remarking "that he supposed she would then leave Salem or at least the county jail."
