**INDIAN WAR VETERANS MEET.**  
 They Adopt Some Strong Resolutions Saturday.

At a meeting of Bennett Camp No. 8, Indian War Veterans held in the police court room at the city hall Saturday afternoon, resolutions pertaining to the bill and its subsequent passage, that is now before the house of representatives which provided for the survivors of the late Indian wars, were passed.

Col. T. B. Wait presided at the meeting and Chas. Calvert kept a record of the minutes.

Several reminiscent speeches were made and Col. T. B. Wait introduced the following resolution which was unanimously adopted:

"Whereas, Over forty-two years ago we defended the citizens of the Pacific Northwest against the tomahawk and scalping-knife of the hordes of merciless savages that infested this country then. In 1855 and '56 all of the tribes north of California west of the summit of the Rocky Mountains, south of British Columbia and east of the Pacific ocean, were on the warpath (with the exception of the Lawyer's band of Nez Percés) occupying a territory so large that if the island of Cuba could have been dropped in the center of it, it might have been years before it would have been discovered.

"Whereas, We as young Americans, responded to the call, furnishing our arms and equipments in the majority of cases.

"Whereas, Some of us, after waiting seven years, received one-third the pay of the regular army of the United States, others nothing, and that is all the recognition we have ever received for our services, save just before an election somebody who wanted to be returned to the United States senate dropped in a center of it, it might have been years before it would have been discovered.

"Whereas, We as young Americans, responded to the call, furnishing our arms and equipments in the majority of cases.
