# NAVY WILL SHELL THE CITY.

## American Soldiers Will Take the Restoring Dons.

OFF AGUADORES, July 13.—The navy have solved the problem of how to take Santiago a city four and a half miles away, and concealed from view by a range of hills 250 feet high at its lowest part?

The problem has been satisfactorily solved. If the army hereafter never fires a shot and weekly guards the roads, the navy could make Santiago untenable, if indeed, it did not destroy it in a few days.

For two days the sea has been calmer than usual and a splendid opportunity was given for good gunnery practice.

In pursuance of General Shafter's request, Commodore Schley, Rear Admiral Sampson being absent at Guantanamo, at 3 o'clock Sunday afternoon arranged the Brooklyn, Indiana and Texas within 500 yards of the shore, at a point almost due south of the city of Santiago, and distant a little over four and a half miles. The ships were about a mile apart. The army signal men were on the beach opposite the ships and also on the crest of the hill, overlooking both ships and city.

These men wigwagged the results of each shot, telling the gunners if the shell was aimed too high or low, or not in line.

Sunday's practice was good, but it was better Monday, when the fire was opened by the New York, which returned from Guantanamo during the night. The New York, Brooklyn and Indiana were the ships which participated in the shelling this morning. Each shot was carefully calculated, and the wigwags signalled from the shore to the ships where each shot fell, and notified the gunners if they had the proper elevation. The ships ran out their big guns on the side opposite the firing guns, in order to obtain the desired list to port or to starboard.

General Shafter signalled about noon "that some of the shells fell in the bay and some in the city. The latter do not appear to do great damage."

Comment on this subject was changed immediately by a message:

"The last shot struck St. Nicholas church, where powder was stored, blowing up the same and doing great damage."

Not a gun was fired by the Spaniards. Four shells, during the bombardment, ignited fires in different parts of the city, proving the feasibility of burning the place by using the guns of the fleet alone. Death must have come to many in the city by reason of the shelling.

### WAR TAX STAMP.

Assistant Attorney-General Boyd's Opinion.

WASHINGTON, July 13.—In answer to inquiries from the collectors of internal revenue, all bearing upon the question as to whether the shipper or the carrier shall pay for, and affix the required revenue stamps to bills of lading, Assistant Attorney-General Boyd has held as follows:

"The law makes it the duty of every railroad and steamboat company, carrier, express company, corporation or person whose occupation it is to carry such, to issue to the shipper, from whom any goods are accepted for transportation, a bill of lading, a manifesto or some other acknowledgment of the goods, received for carriage and transportation, and this bill of lading requires a revenue stamp of the value of 1 cent. The purpose of the law is clear. It was to tax the corporation and not the shipper, and the provisions undoubtedly fix upon the express companies and other carriers the duty of providing, affixing and cancelling the stamps."

WASHINGTON, July 13.—Major DeGrandprey, military attaché of the French embassy, has just returned from the American headquarters near Santiago, where he has been observing for his government, the progress of the military operations. He paid a glowing tribute to the ability of our soldiers:

"I have the most complete admiration for your men," said Major DeGrandprey to an Associated Press representative today. "They are a superb body individually, and as an army, and I suppose that not throughout the world is there such a splendid lot of fighting men. They are aggressive, eager for action, never needing the voice of officers to push them forward."

"Another marked characteristic is the self reliance of each man, what I call the character of 'initiative'. It is almost unknown in European armies, where every movement and move, to meet each action of the enemy awaits the initiative of the officers. The Spanish troops do not have this same characteristic. They are more passive, more cautious."
