APPROPRIATION BILL Full Text of the Senate Bill an Prepared by the Committee. To provide for the ordinary ex-

penses of the state government and general appropriations. Be it enacted by the legislative as sembly of the state of Oregon:

Section 1: That the following sums and no more, are hereby appropriated for the several objects hereinafter named, for the two years commencing on the first day of January, A. D, 1899, to be paid out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated.






