GOV. GEER, GIVE THE PEOPLE A GOOD STATE FAIR BOARD.

The governor has to appoint five new members of a state fair board, who are to be hereafter a state board of agriculture. The present state officials and young men, comparatively, and they will live to see the results of the work of this state fair board. The governor is himself a farmer, and knows that a good agricultural fair would be a benefit to the state, while a bad one will be a curse to him, to his party, and to the taxpayers and to the growing generations.

THE OREGONIAN'S PERIODICAL ROASTS OF THE STATE PRINTER.

During the legislative, and before and since, the Portland newspaper that goes all over the state indulged in very severe roasts of the state printer. Senators close to that paper kept up a running fire of bills, resolutions, investigations and speeches against the state printing office. This all attracted attention at the time, but after adjournment the same paper came out in a leading editorial on the state printing office, charging that the whole legislature had been organized for its benefit, including election of Speaker Carter, appointments of committees, etc.

This was a pretty severe indictment of the Republican party from a Republican standpoint. It charged the Republican state printer with having the power to organize the legislature and charged by inference that there was collusion between the state printer and speaker.

What was the surprise created by

the appearance of the following back-down in Saturday's Oregonian:

The amount of money appropriated for public printing is easily accessible; but the total amount of printing done for the state, and the cost to the state printer, is more difficult to ascertain. The outlay of the printer is probably known to no one but himself, and can only be estimated by others. The claims of accounts audited and allowed for several biennial periods show a decrease in cost of printing in the past few years. High-water mark in the amount of printing for the state and its various institutions was reached in 1893-1894. The total cost for that biennial period was \$101,002.56. For the biennial term of 1895-1896, the total cost was \$92,755.32. For the biennial term of 1897-1898 the total cost was \$75,955.11. These sums cover the deficiency.

All the "printing appropriation" is not drawn or handled by the state printer. The chief item of \$60,000 in the biennial appropriation for printing is for the "paper" and "binding." All the paper is bought by the secretary of state, but is paid for out of the so-called "printing fund."

Like the binding for the state is done under the direction of the secretary of state, independent of the printing office, but its bills are audited and allowed from the so-called "printing fund." These two items, paper and binding, amounted to more than \$35,500 in the last four years, and will require a like proportion of the printing fund in the future.

Now that the legislature has limited the state printing office to specified sums for various boards, commissions, societies, etc., the term 1899-1900 will probably show a considerable decrease from the preceding biennial term.

The above figures in the Oregonian show a reduction of \$8,387.24 during Mr. Leland's first biennial term, and a reduction of \$25,107.45 for his second biennial term from "High-water mark" in 1893-94.

These are correct official figures that were cut out of the report of the investigating committee and have heretofore been carefully suppressed.

Does not the above, when considered with the Oregonian's severe attacks on the management of the state printing office, convict it of being extremely illogical, not to say inconsistent? It will certainly require some explanation, if all that the Oregonian has charged is true, how the expenses for printing the past four years have been reduced over \$25,000.
