MADRID, Dec. 28.—The premier, Senor Silveira, formally announced at yesterday's session of the cabinet council that he had had an interview with the United States minister, Bellamy Storer, who had informed him that the United States government would undertake the repatriation of the families of the Spanish prisoners in the Philippines.
