### BRITISH CHECK THE BOER ADVANCE AT ELAND'S LAAGTE

### Boers Given Relief By Ballot to go and Plant Their Farms.

It is announced in general orders that General Sir Herbert Sherbrooke has been appointed to command the Third division, vice General Sir William Gatacre, 'ordered home to England.'

"General Brabant's force is confident of being able to hold out. The Boers, after showing considerable dash, wavered when it came to the final issue, and have struck at least the vital point, where they are greatly handicapped by their proximity to the Basuto border."

### Report of a Gold Find on the Koyokuk—\$100 to the Pan.

The King Solomon Mining Co., has been capitalized for \$30,000,000 and has secured hundreds of claims along Lake Kootenai near Ainsworth, B. C. Half a million dollars will be expended this season.

SEASIDE, April 12.—The news has been brought up the Yukon by way of Dawson that reports of strikes of almost incredible wealth in gold have been made along the Koyokuk, and that camps along the Yukon have been greatly excited, and half of them are deserted by the men going on stampedes to the new districts. Jack Bourne arrived at Dawson from Circle City by dog team, bringing the report. Mr. Bourne says the wildest stories are in circulation as to the extent of the pay. One report has it that \$100 to the pan is a common thing, and he was assured by a reliable and conservative man that the diggings would average \$50 a day to the man. The gold is bright, pure, and assays \$19 to the ounce.

LONDON, April 12.—The Bloemfontein correspondent of the Morning Post, telegraphing Tuesday, says:

"The Boers to the southeast are exhibiting indecision of movement, possibly in consequence of our occupation of the railway. Bodies of the enemy are still moving from Winburg southward through Thabanchu. Their destination has not been ascertained. Boers in the neighborhood of Paardeburg show no disposition to interrupt our communication with Kimberley, from which point civil convoys are still arriving."
