## MINERAL PARK CHANGES HANDS.

J. S. Basler Takes Charge of the Popular Seaside Resort.

But perhaps the pleasant feature of the place is the absence of the disagreeable high winds which prevail at the other coast resorts.

## LAKEVIEW ENTERPRISE.

The Plaster Gets Out an Extra Before the Ashes Are Cold.

The Lakeview Rustler is well named. The day after the fire, which wiped out the business part of the unfortunate town of Lakeview, the Rustler got together a few galleys of type and issued an extra before the smoke of the conflagration had cleared away.

The fire, which started in a hotel at 8 p. m., made a very thorough clean-up of the business part of the town, but one business house, the Daly concrete building, being left standing. Dr. Draly's loss on other property is placed at \$30,000.

The establishments which were destroyed were seven general merchandise stores, brewery, livery stable, two drug stores, four saloons, two newspaper offices, millinery store, jewelry and machinery, dentist's office, bank, U. S. land office, blacksmith shop, saddle and harness, barber shop, two hardware stores, three hotels, two bicycle shops, furniture and undertaker's, two dry goods stores, three confectionery, shoe shop, butcher shop, doctor's office, restaurant, two lodges, the town hall and four dwellings. The loss is placed at \$350,000, with some insurance.

The spirit of the people is indicated by the following, from the Rustler's extra:

The business portion of Lakeview is temporarily a black spot of vacancy on the face of the earth. It will not remain so long, however, for goods are being ordered by wire, and contracts are being let as fast as figures can be made for material and building. Some of our business men have already secured temporary quarters and are selling such goods as they saved from the flames. The hardware implements for lawns, gardens and other uses, and it is common to see all kinds of business carried on under the same roof and in the same room. They resemble department stores on a small scale in many instances.

Those who have been left homeless have found temporary abiding places with generous friends. There has not been a single instance of actual suffering for the necessities of life. The people have been patient and borne their losses with scarcely a murmur.

Three hundred and fifty thousand dollars is a low estimate of the total loss. The insurance is small. But the victims are generally young and thorough business men, and will soon make back what they have lost.
