Work of Taking the Census in Oregon Drawing to a Close.

It is important that no one be missed. Salem's population as known throughout the country at large for the next ten years will be determined by the thoroughness of the work now being prosecuted. The enumerators have been careful, and quite completely covered the ground. But, it is inevitable that some be missed, and these should be found. Residents of the city are asked to give the matter enough attention to notify this office, if they have not been enumerated, by the middle of this week, merely leaving their names indicating what ward they live. The enumerators will then call and get the information required.

The people in general should bear in mind that upon the total population found in Oregon at this time will depend the securing of another congressman for Oregon. There is a good prospect that this will be accomplished, but if it is all the people must be found. The advantage of having an additional congressional representative will be apparent to all, and in assisting to get all the names of the people for the census one will be contributing towards this end.

It is hoped that the residents of Salem will make a special effort to help the enumerators to get the names.

Supervisor of census, Curtis B. Winn of Albany, writes THE JOURNAL as follows:

"I would be very glad to have your cooperation in bringing about the best possible results in the matter of obtaining a record and complete enumeration of the residents of your city. I should be very glad if you would ask, through the columns of your paper, any persons who may have been overlooked by the census enumerator, to report that fact to your paper."

"I realize that I am asking a good deal of you, but I am sure this is a matter in which we are all vitally interested, and in no way can the matter be brought so clearly before the people as by the aid and assistance of the press. I would thank you for any suggestions that you may be able to make where any improvement could be made in the manner of taking the work or in any way that will add to its effectiveness. I enclose some franked envelopes, should you wish occasion to write me on that subject."
