In the matter of county aid for Mrs. C. Schaffer—Monthly allowance placed at \$5.

In the matter of hospital care for Mrs. Brooks—Ordered that Mrs. M. E. Brooks be admitted to the hospital with the understanding that Marion County will not be liable for a sum greater than \$20 for her care.

In the matter of county aid for Lewis Barnes—Monthly allowance placed at

\$3 per month with L. H. Poujade disbursing agent.

In the matter of a voting place in Silver Falls Precinct—Ordered that Judges and Clerks of election in said Precinct be notified that the polling place is the school house in District No. 107 and that S. B. Ormsby be instructed to see to the moving of booths to said place.

In the matter of application of J. H. Hobart for extension of time in which to complete the assessment roll for 1900—Ordered that time for completion of said roll be extended until November 12, 1900, and that time for meeting of Board of Equalization be fixed at said date.

In the matter of the report of W. W. Hall, clerk of warrant drawn on salary account for August and September—approved.

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In the matter of the application of P. M. Hangshaw and Mrs. U. G. Longworth for rebate on road tax on account of use of wide tire wagon—approved, and supervisor of respective districts to rebate the taxes of said persons in accordance with law.
