## VICTORY FOR QUEEN LIL

HONOLULU, Nov. 9, via., San Francisco, Nov. 10.—Robert W. Wilcox, Independent Royalist, has been elected elected Hawaiian delegate to congress over Samuel Parker, Republican. His strong vote among the natives in the outside districts carried the day against the whites and intelligent native voters of the cities.

The news of the result of the election produced much distress among the whites. Wilcox's campaign was an anti-white canvass with promises on the part of some of the campaign workers that if he were elected Queen Liliuokalani would be replaced on the throne.

The independent native party carried the honor of Representatives by a large majority. It is likely as a result of the election that congress will be asked to establish some limitations on voting privileges. The natives have won upon a race division and now the whites want a property qualification for voters.
