FRANCE AND GERMANY FORCE THE CHINESE

To Retire by Starting After Them With a Large United Expedition

IMPERIAL DECREE PROMPTLY ISSUED STOPS PROCEEDINGS AND SAVES TROUBLE

Russia Playing for Power in Northern China—Japan Refuses Russian Advances—European Powers Conducting Military Movements as the Basis of Heaping up Larger Indemnity Claims Against the Kingdom of the Black Dragon.

New York, April 16.—A dispatch to the Herald from Peking says: General Looset, commanding the German troops in China, has started for Bao Ting Fu with 10,000 additional men. He was accompanied by the French General Bailoud. Forces of the expedition number 18,000 men.

PERIN, April 19.—In consequence of the strong representations to the Chinese government in Imperial decree has been issued ordering Chinese troops at Howai Lu to immediately remove outside the great wall. The troops whose withdrawal has been ordered are understood to be the force which the German and French expedition were preparing to attack.

LONDON, April 19.—A dispatch from Paris says that in consequence of the Imperial decree ordering Chinese troops to leave the territory considered under the protection of the allied forces, the Franco-German expedition has been abandoned. France will shortly withdraw 10,000 troops from China.

Daily News publishes the following from its Shanghai correspondent: I learn that Prince Tuan and General Tung in Hsian last January sent a deputation to the Russians in the vicinity of Lake Baikal, praying for protection and declaring their readiness to acknowledge the sovereignty of Russia if the Russians withheld their project for re-occupying the Northern province of China.

It is expected that the palace fire will give the Empress Dowager another excuse for delaying the return of the court to Peking. Some of the London papers publish a statement that Russia has offered to reduce her indemnity claim to £10,000,000 on condition the China signs the Manchurian convention and grants further concessions in connection with the Siberian Railway.

"Russia has made new and specific proposals to Japan," says the Yokohama correspondent of the Daily Mail, "for a mutual understanding but Japan gives no sign of accepting."

RUSSIAN BUTTER EXPORT INCREASING

WASHINGTON, April 19.—"Russia in recent years has been creating a large export trade in butter," reports Consul Mahin, at Reichenberg to the State De-

partment. The export in 1897 amounted to 19,081,050 pounds and for the first 10 months in 1900 the exports doubled that amount, being 37,729,270 pounds.

The principal increase of export is in the butter product of Siberia. To facilitate the trade, better trains, equipped with refrigerating apparatus have been employed to transport the goods to the ports for shipment. During the season of 1900, two special trains of 25 cars each were dispatched weekly loaded with butter from Baltic ports where, in four months 14,428,000 pounds were delivered.
